INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the web profiles portal: <http://devinfo.stat.gov.rs/diProfili>!

The profile is an xlsx/pdf document that contains key indicators organized by themes. They are presented in a simple and clear way, in the form of tables, graphs and maps. The profiles are available from the level of the Republic of Serbia down to the level of municipalities/cities.

The web profiles portal is an interactive web application based on the DevInfo technology and supports the following:

- Selection of indicators from the database and presentation on the map
- Selection of the city/municipality on the map and provision of the profile of the selected city or municipality
- Provision of profiles for any of the territorial levels from the list (Republic of Serbia, region, district, city/municipality) by simple browsing or search, and
- Download of all existing profiles (using the tab *Downloads*).

The application supports two languages: Serbian and English.

Access to the web profiles portal

The web profiles portal is a web application that can be accessed via web browser (software application used to display content of the web pages).

These are the steps to be followed to access this application:

- Start Internet Explorer or any other web browser (Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, etc.)
- Type the following web address and press ENTER:

Remark: Use of Adobe Flash and Adobe Reader



In order to use the map in this application, your web browser has to support Adobe Flash. If the map fails to display on this website, this means that your web browser does not support Adobe Flash. More information about the installation of Adobe Flash are available in the: Appendix – Installation of Adobe Flash.

Adobe Reader (<http://get.adobe.com/reader/otherversions/>) or any other software that supports pdf format is required to view the profile in pdf format.

CHAPTER 1 – Select by map

Selection of indicators from the map

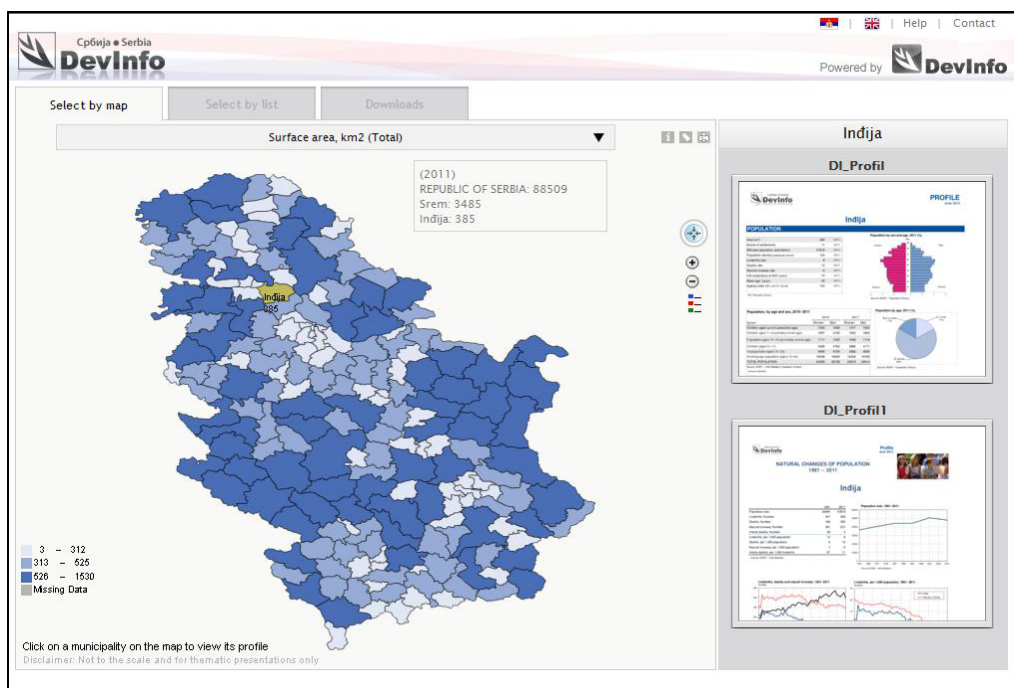


Fig. 1.1 Web profiles portal, tab *Select by map*

When opening the web profiles portal, the tab *Select by map* will be opened (Fig. 1.1).

In the upper right corner of the screen you will find icons and links for language selection (Serbian or English), help and contact (E-mail: devinfo@stat.gov.rs) (Fig. 1.2).

On the map, only most up-to-date database values for one indicator can be displayed at the same time. The border values and colors for the indicator ranges are shown in the legend that is located in the lower left corner of the map.

The indicator is to be selected as follows:

- Click the arrow on the right side of the indicator name to open the menu with available sectors (to close the menu click the arrow once again) (Fig. 1.3).

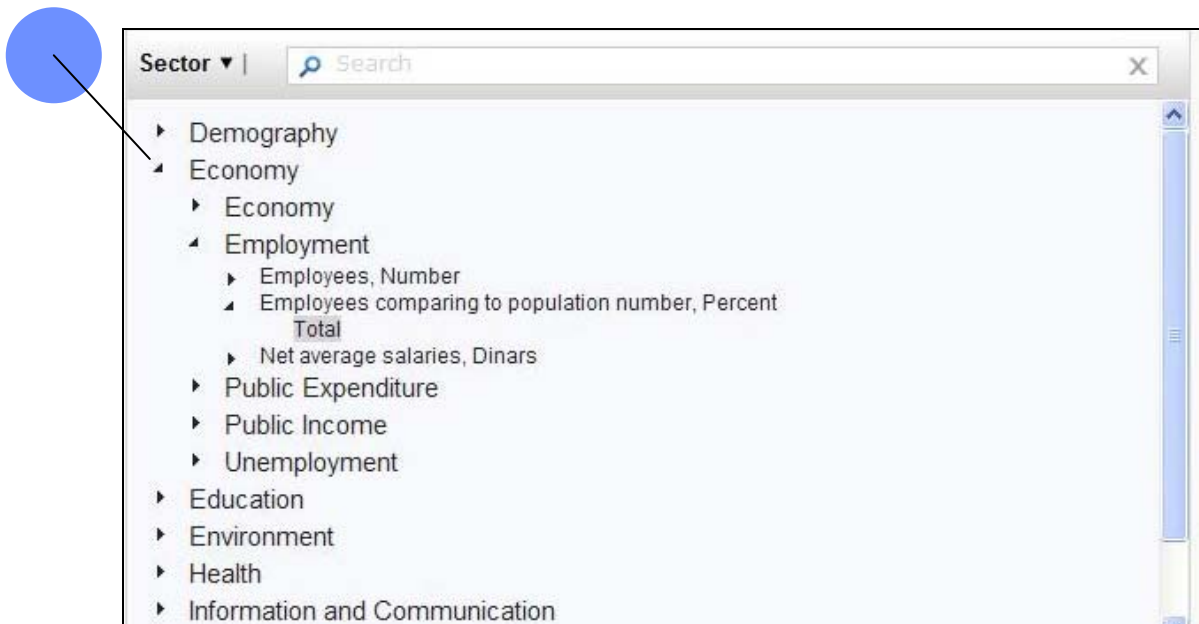


Fig. 1.4 View of sectors, sub-sectors and indicators

- Click the arrow on the left side of the sector name to view the sub-sectors and indicators within the sector and then click on the indicator (Fig. 1.4).

In the above example, the indicator **Employees comparing to population number** is selected (the unit is **Percent**, subgroup **Total**). By a simple click on **Total** the map with values for the selected indicator will open.

Map tools

The obtained map can be zoomed in/out, printed, and the display of labels (names of municipalities/cities) on the map can be switched on or off. Furthermore, for the selected indicator you can obtain the relevant metadata.

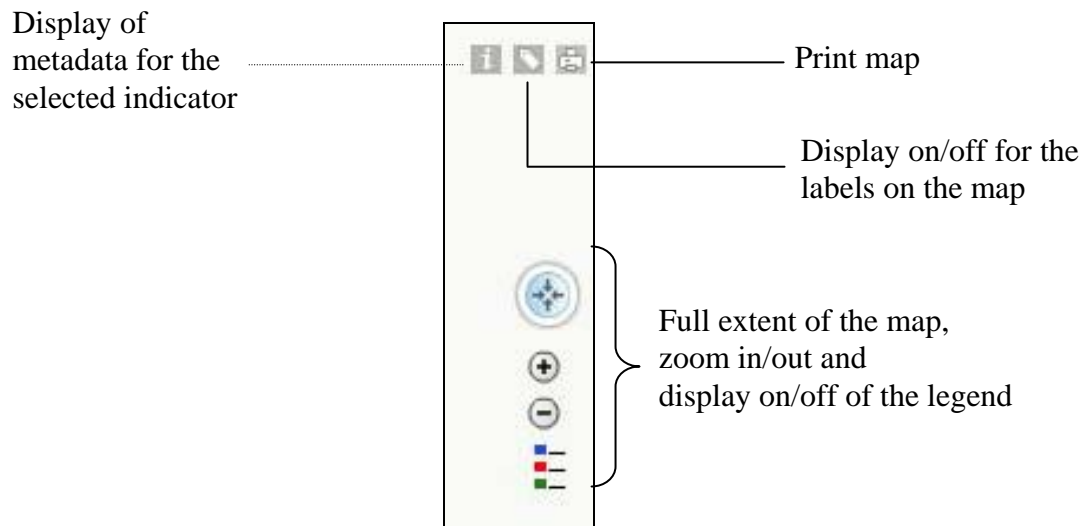


Fig. 1.5 Map tools

Map tools are explained in Fig. 1.5.

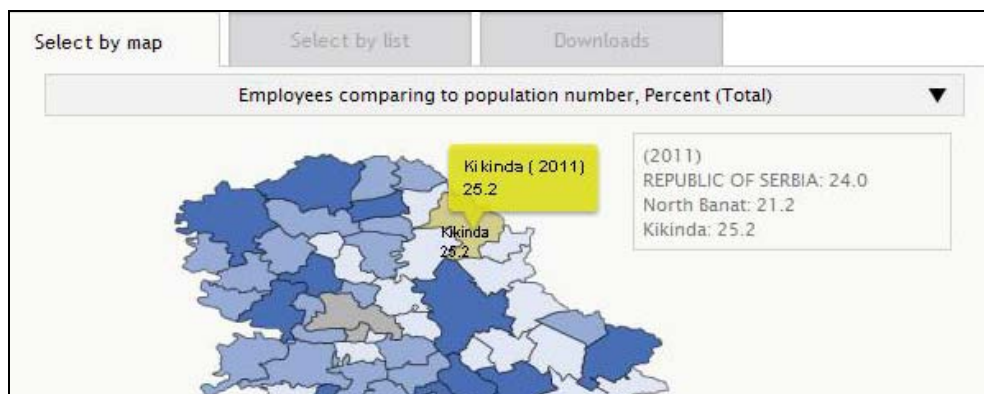


Fig. 1.6 Value of the indicator displayed on the map

By pointing with the mouse on the municipality on the map, the name of the municipality, the year the data refers to and the value of the indicator will appear in a yellow rectangle with transparent background (Fig. 1.6).

By clicking on a selected municipality (Fig. 1.6) the value for the Republic of Serbia and the district where the selected municipality is located (for easier comparison) will appear inside a rectangle as additional information for the selected indicator.

Selection of profiles from the map

On the right side of the map there are a downsized frames for two available profiles, for the selected municipality/city. The first/upper profile (DI_Profil) contains detailed information for selected municipality/city from the database Monitoring situation and development of municipalities. The second/lower is thematic and contains data from the database Natural changes of population, from 1961 till 2011.

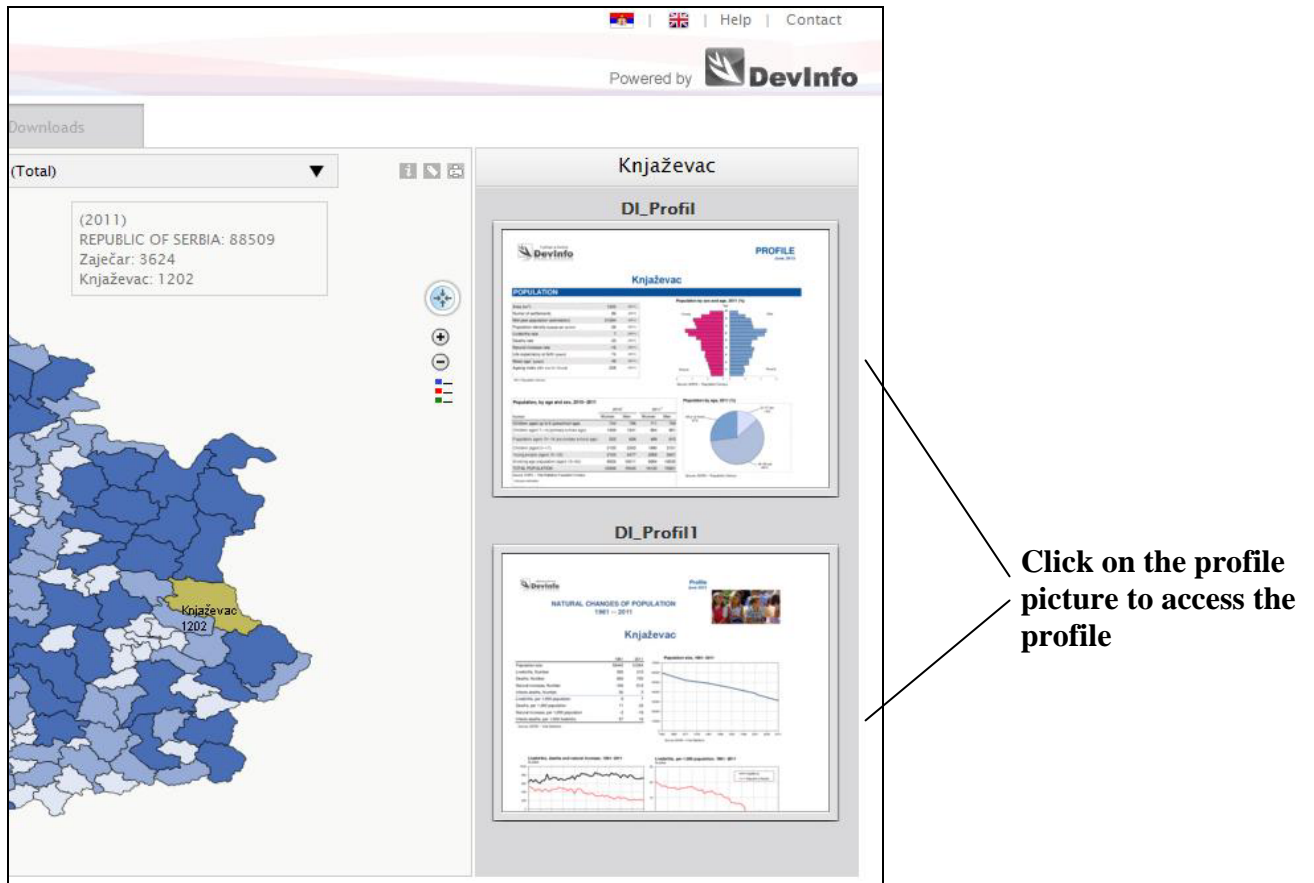


Fig. 1.7 Display of all available profiles for the selected municipality

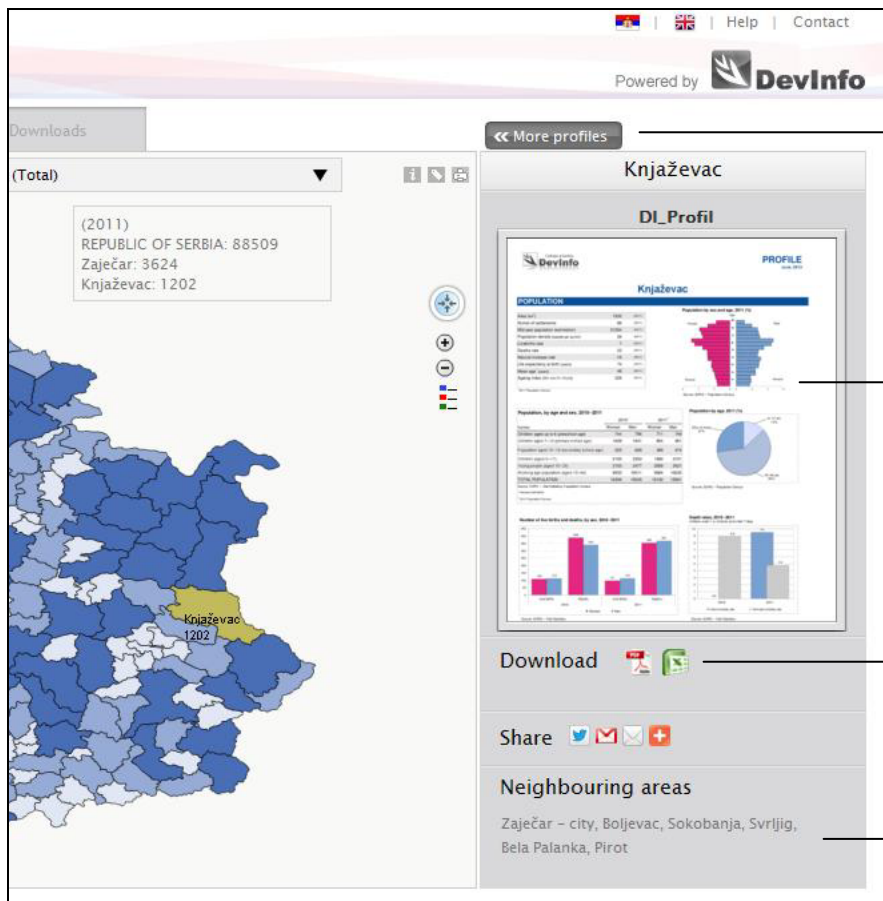


Fig. 1.8 Display and browsing of the profile for the selected municipality

By clicking any picture you can access the selected profile (Fig. 1.8)

By clicking on this frame, a pdf profile will open. By clicking on the pdf or excel icons that are placed below the downsized frame, you can download the profile (Fig. 1.8).

CHAPTER 2 – Select by list and Downloads

Selection from the list and download

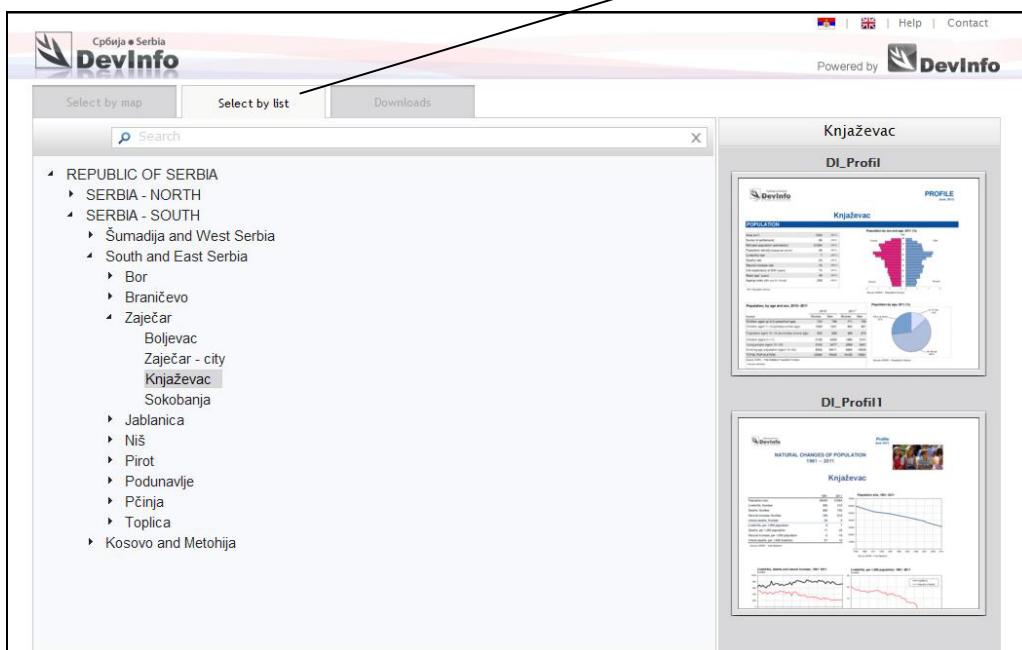


Fig. 2.1 Selection of profiles by list

The map allows access only to profiles of municipalities. To access and view profiles for higher territorial levels (Republic of Serbia, region, district) click on the tab *Select by list* (Fig. 2.1).

Territorial levels can be opened (tree view expanded) by clicking on the arrow on the left side of the area name. A simple click on the area name displays on the right side a small picture for the available profiles. For quick search you can use the search text box (please select Cyrillic or English keyboard depending on the language you are using).

The tab *Downloads* has a table with all areas. From this tab you can download all profiles (in total 239) or only the profile for a selected region, district, municipality or city (for instance: Kraljevo – city).

Appendix – Installation of Adobe Flash

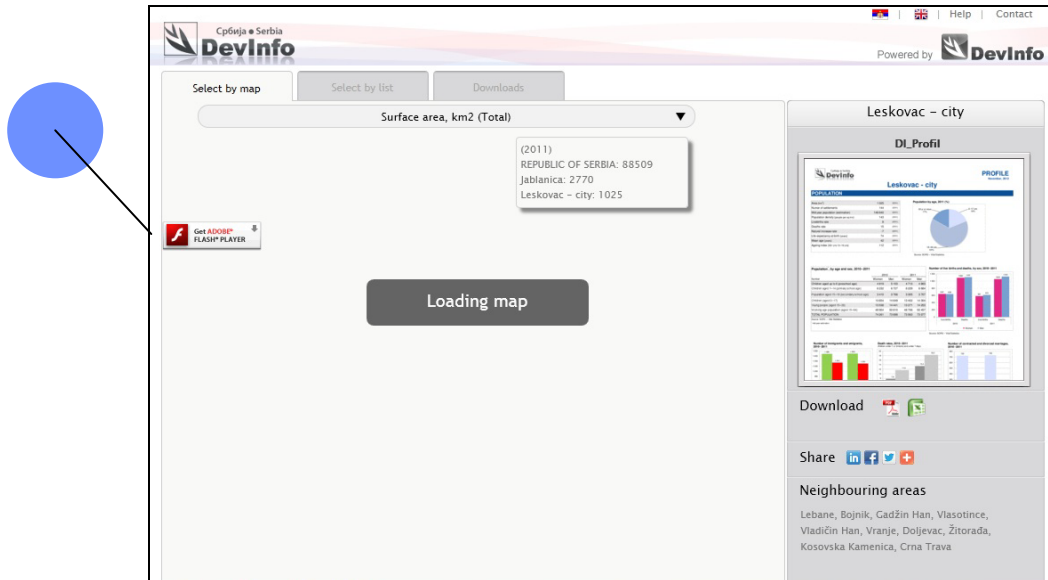


Fig. 1 Link for installing Adobe Flash

Adobe Flash is required for display and use of the map. If it is not installed, click the logo positioned inside the space for map display, to install the software¹ (Fig. 1).

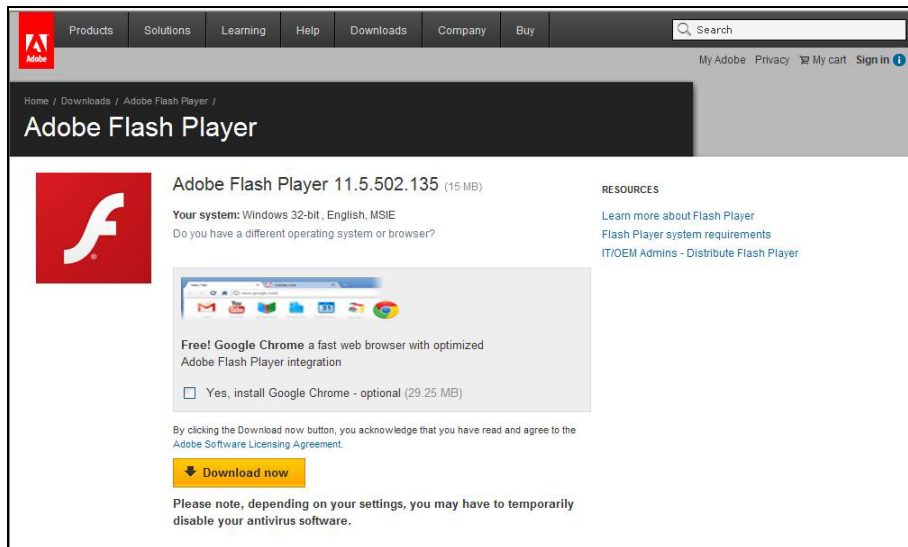


Fig. 2 Adobe Flash download page

This is how you can access Adobe website, from where you can download and install the software (Fig. 2).
