



Population by age, 2022



#### Live births by sex, 2020-2022




Deaths by sex, 2020-2022 300





Households according to the number of members, 2022 (%)








#### Average annual net salaries and wages\*, 2021-2023 (RSD)








#### Registered unemployed by sex, 2021-2023\*




Registered unemployed per 1,000 inhabitants, by sex 2020-2022\*






Share of costs by activities in total expenditures of budgetary funds beneficiaries, 2022







## Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2022 (%)










Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2022 (%)





Coverage of children by the preparatory preschool programme, 2020–2022 (%)



Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2018–2020 (%)







#### Students enrolled in primary school, 2022 (%)











## Rate of underage births, 2020–2022 (per 1,000 maternals)





Total number of social protection beneficiaries registered at the Centre for Social Work, 2022









#### Number of child allowance beneficiaries, 2021-2023\*














Land area covered by forest, 2020 (ha)






