





#### Population by five-year age groups and sex, 2023 (%)




Population by age groups, 2023





#### Deaths by sex, 2021-2023









Households according to the number of members, 2022 (%)








#### Average annual net salaries and wages\*, 2021-2023 (RSD)

#### Registered employees by municipalities of residence, 2021-2023\*












Share of costs by activities in total expenditures of budgetary funds beneficiaries, 2023













#### Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2022 (%)







Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2018–2020 (%)







Students enrolled in primary school, 2022 (%)









## Rate of underage births, 2021–2023 (per 1,000 maternals)





Total number of social protection beneficiaries registered at the Centre for Social Work, 2022



Children using accommodation services by type of accommodation, 2021–2023\*











Number of children (aged 6–17) in conflict with the law, 2020–2022















Tourists arrivals, 2021–2023




