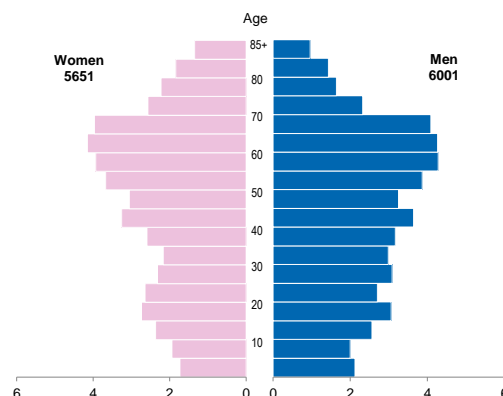

## Population by five-year age groups and sex, 2019 (%)



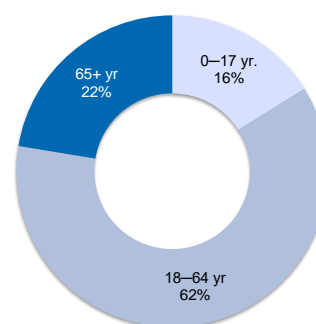

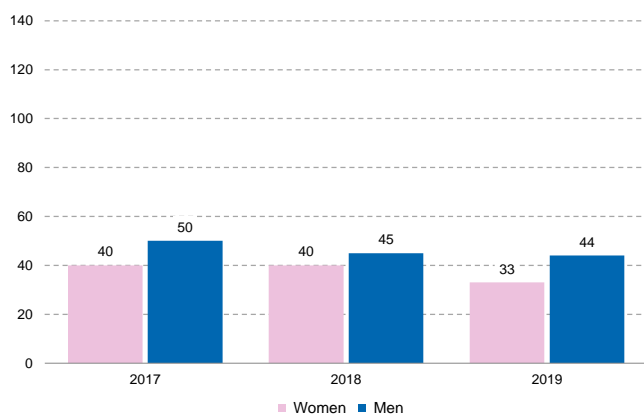

## Population by age, 2019



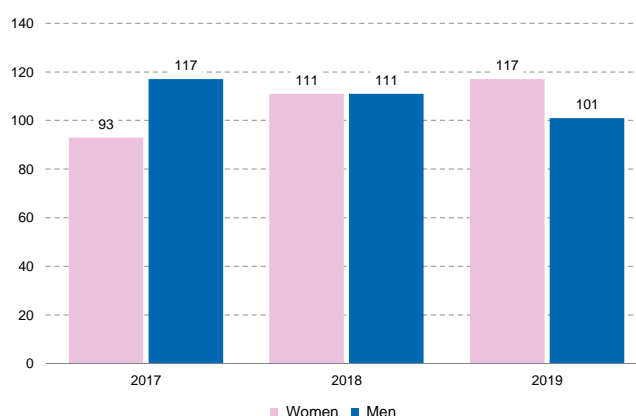

## Live births by sex, 2017–2019



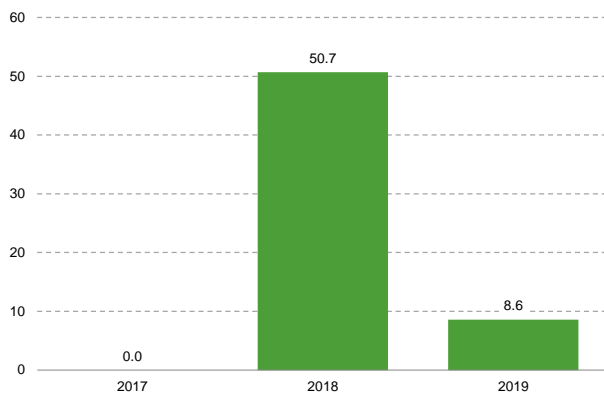

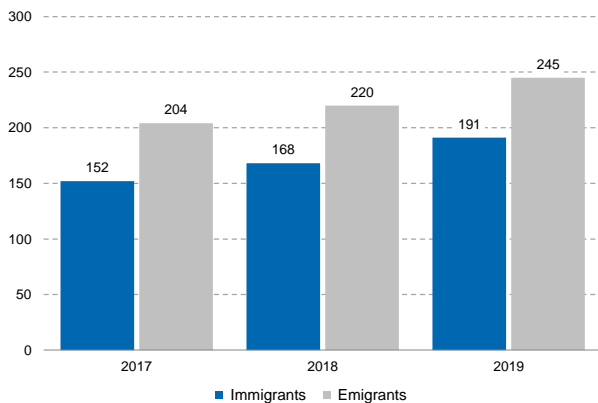

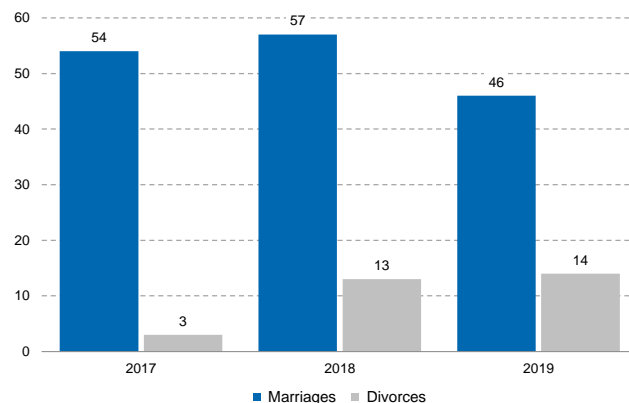

**Immigrants and emigrants, 2017–2019**



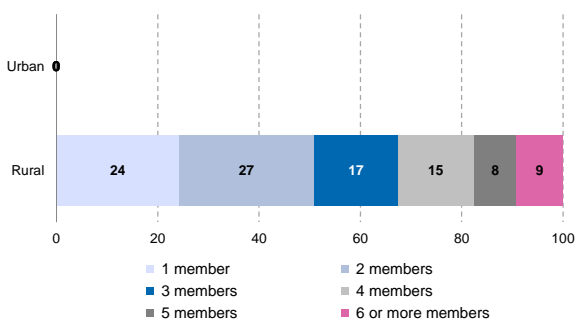

**Marriages and divorces, 2017–2019**



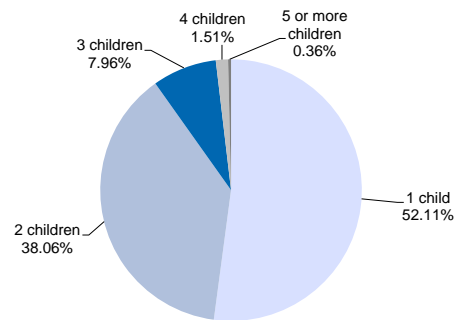

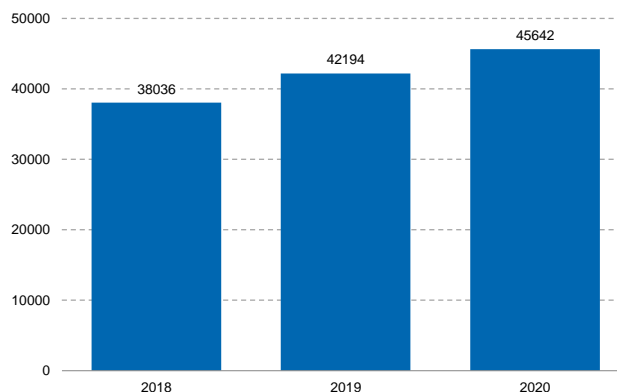

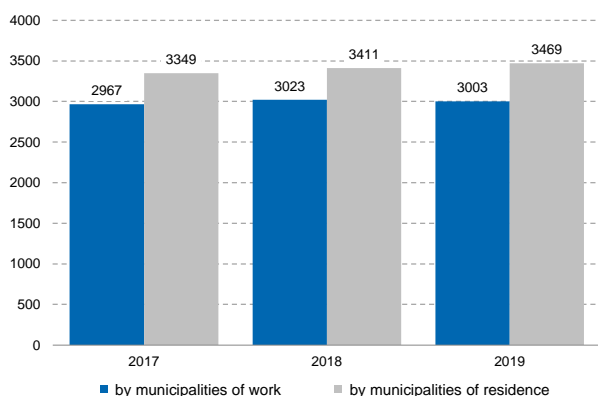
### Average annual net salaries and wages\*, 2018–2020 (RSD)

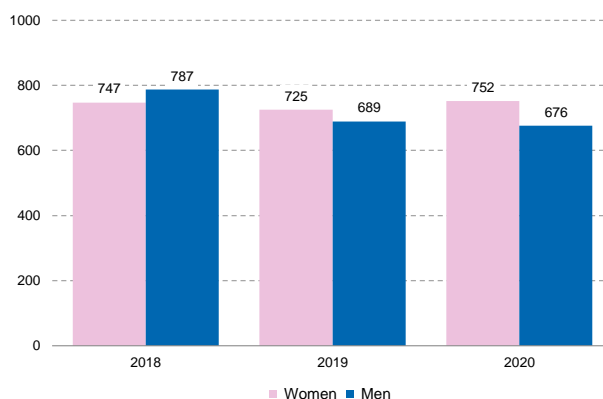
### Registered employees, 2017–2019\*

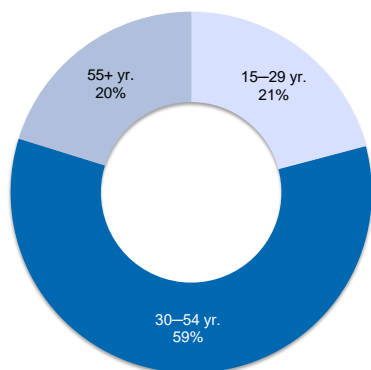
### Registered unemployed by sex, 2018–2020\*

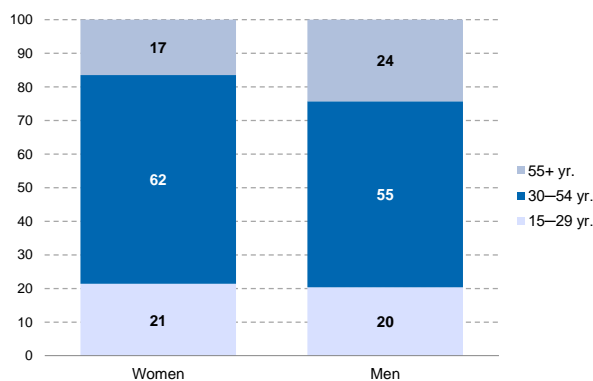

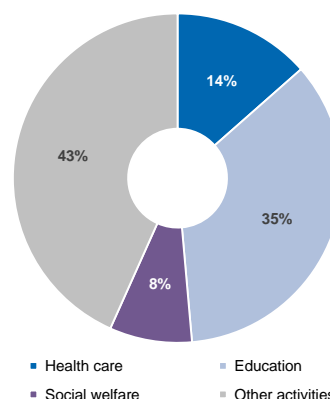

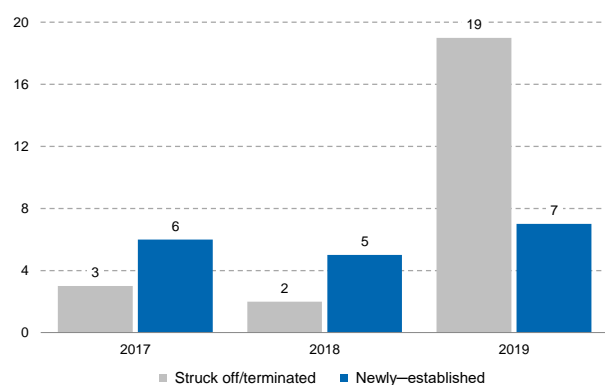

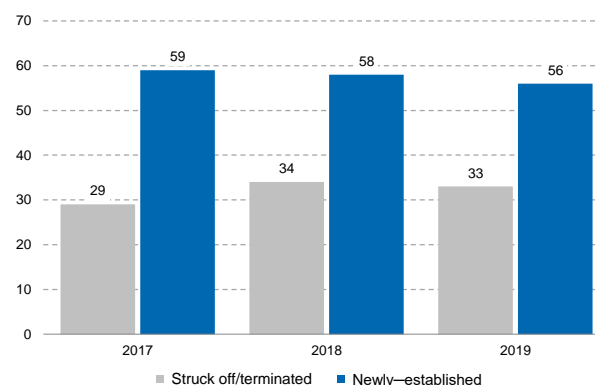

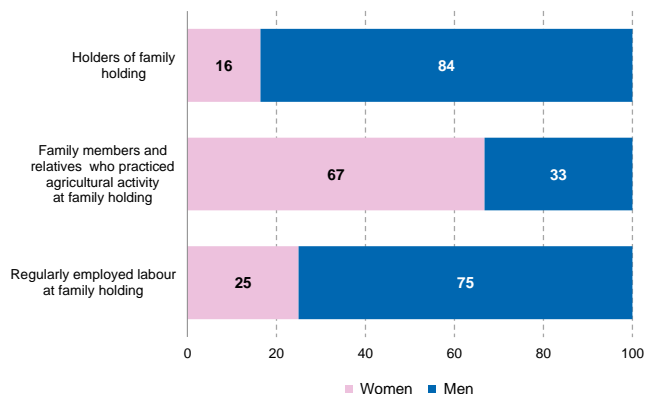

## Members and labour regularly employed at family holding by sex, 2012 (%)



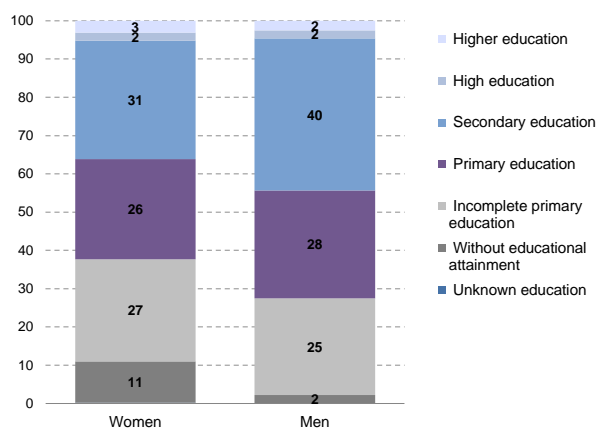

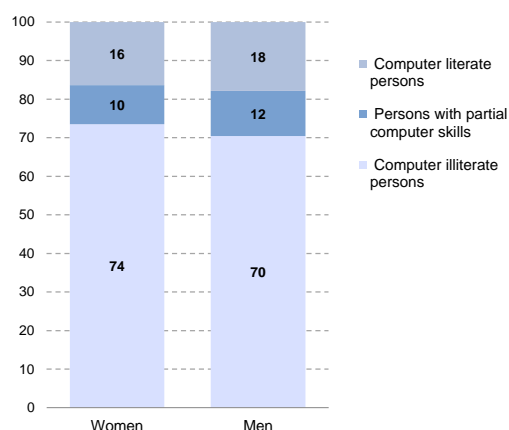

**Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2011 (%)**



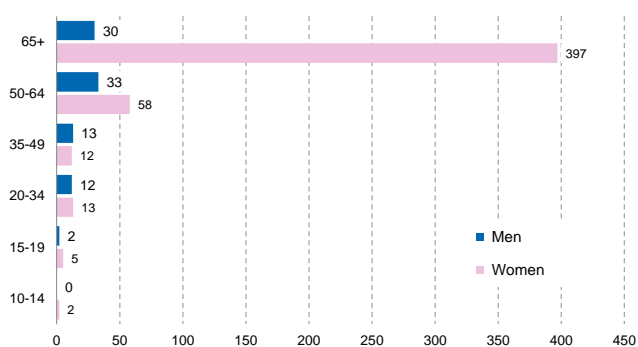

**Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2011 (%)**



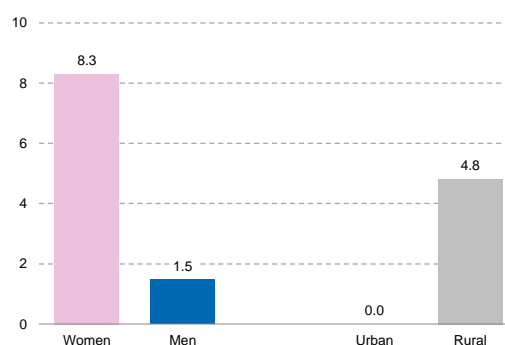

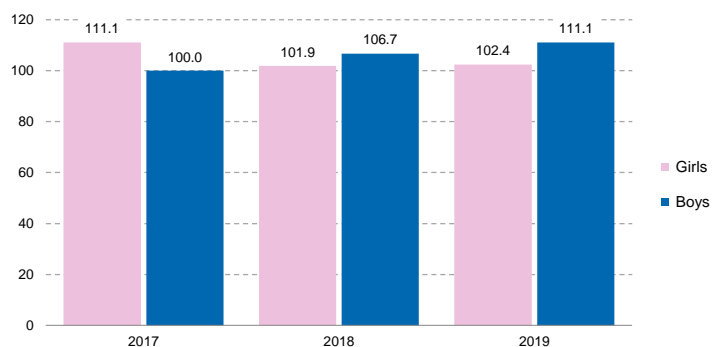

**Coverage of children by the preparatory preschool programme, 2017–2019 (%)**



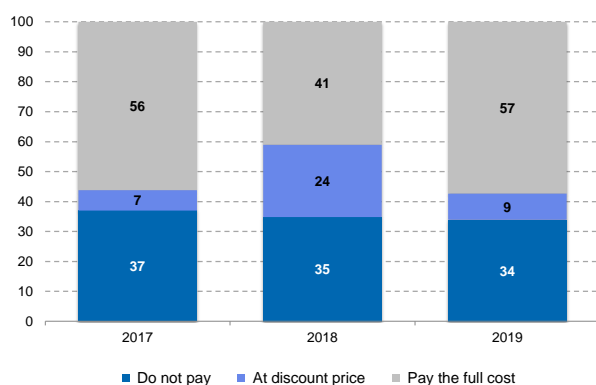

**Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2017–2019 (%)**



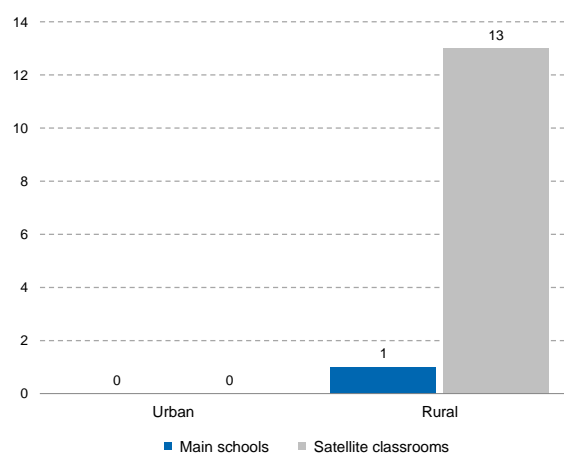

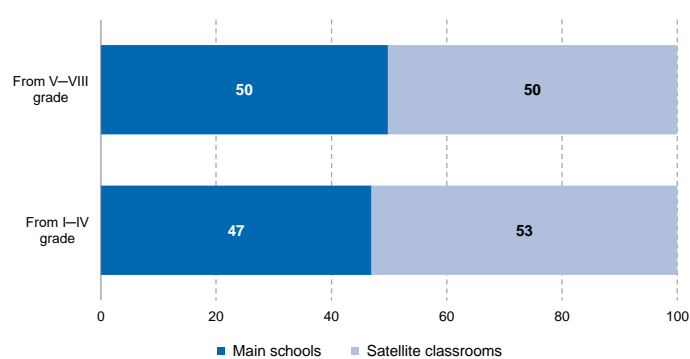
**Primary schools by type of settlement, 2020**

Students enrolled in primary school, 2020 (%)



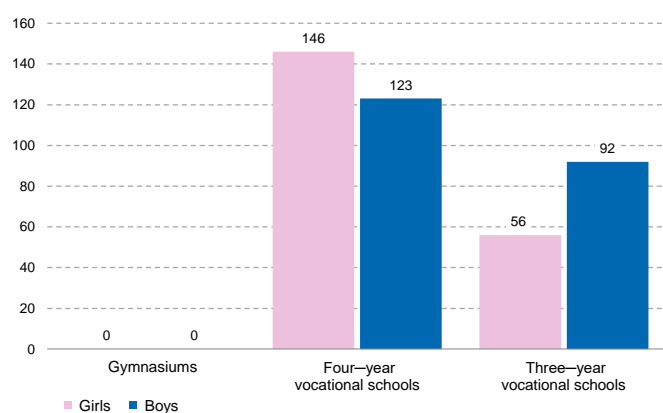

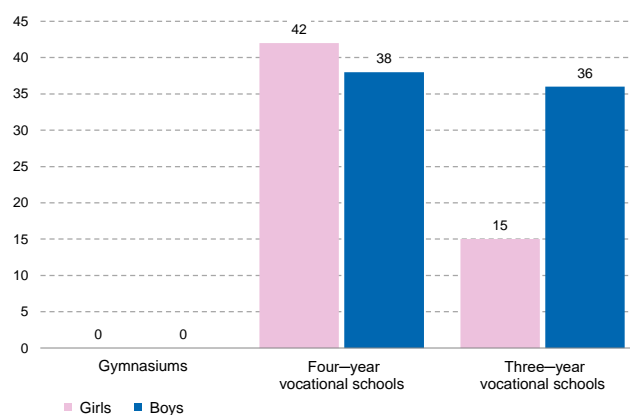

(Per 100,000 population)

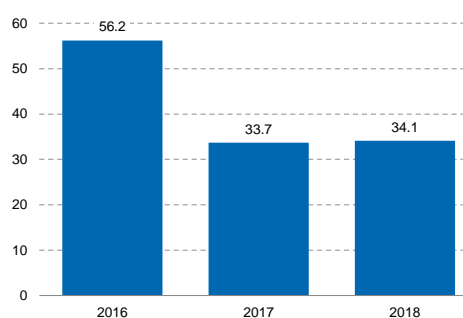

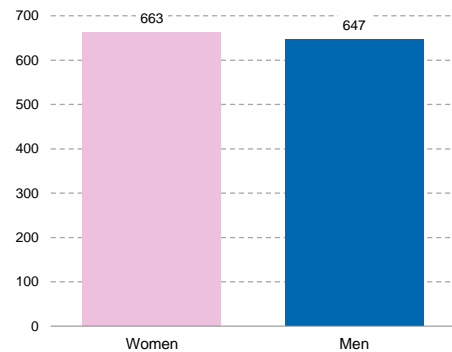

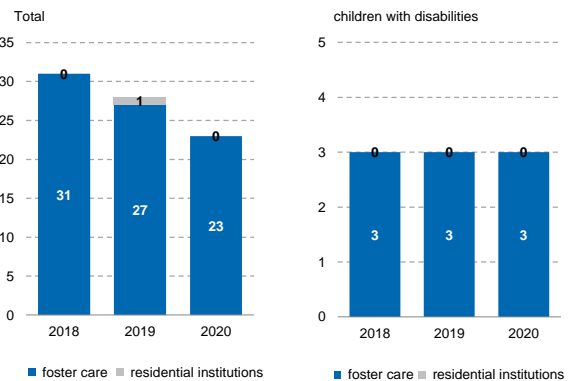

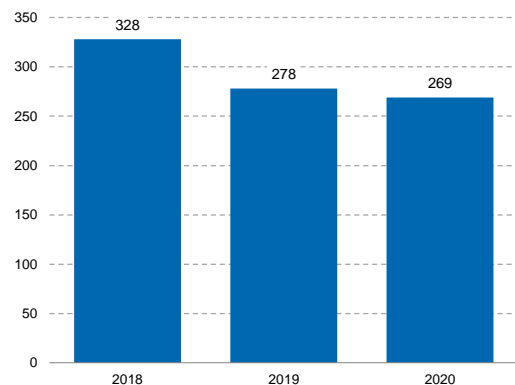

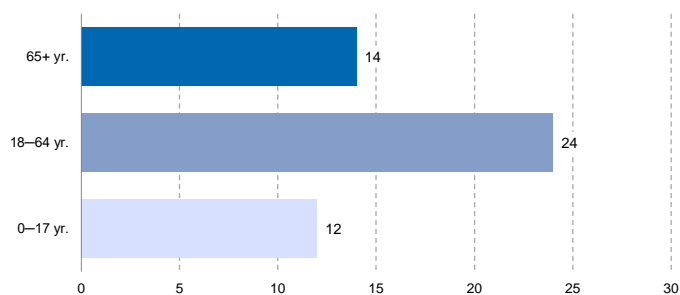
**Number of cash social assistance (income support) beneficiaries, 2018–2020\***

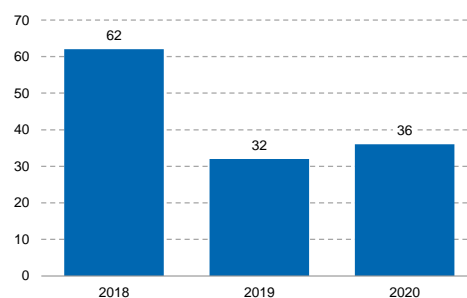
**Number of beneficiaries of basic allowance for assistance and care of another person by age group, 2020\***

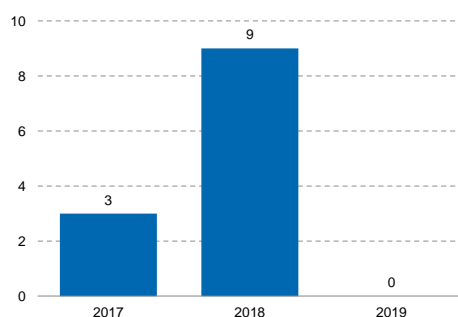

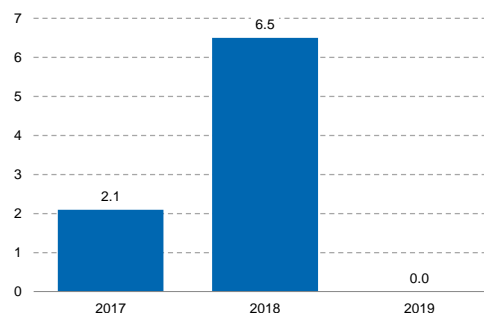

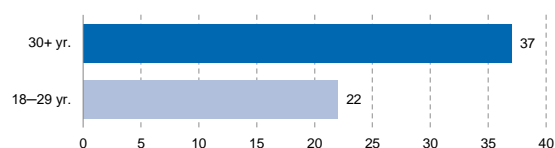

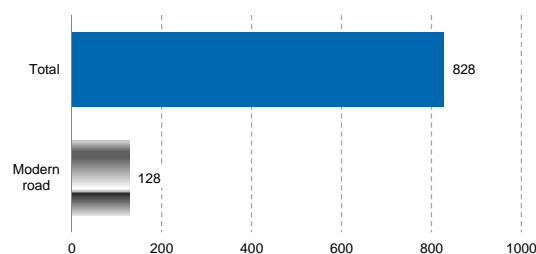

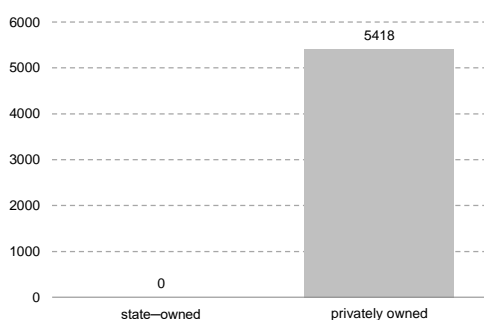

**Length of roads, 2019 (km)**



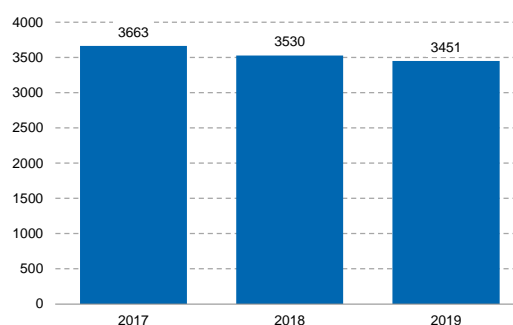
