



Population by age, 2022



#### Live births by sex, 2020-2022





#### Deaths by sex, 2020-2022









Households according to the number of members, 2022 (%)








#### Average annual net salaries and wages\*, 2021-2023 (RSD)





### Registered employees by municipalities of residence, 2020-2022\*






#### Registered unemployed by sex, 2021-2023\*




#### Registered unemployed per 1,000 inhabitants, by sex 2020-2022\*








Share of costs by activities in total expenditures of budgetary funds beneficiaries, 2022







### Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2022 (%)













Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2018–2020 (%)





#### Students enrolled in primary school, 2022 (%)









### Rate of underage births, 2020–2022 (per 1,000 maternals)





Total number of social protection beneficiaries registered at the Centre for Social Work, 2022



Children using accommodation services by type of accommodation, 2021-2023\*






Number of cash social assistance (income support) beneficiaries (persons), 2021-2023\*

Number of beneficiaries of basic allowance for assistance and care of another person by age group,  $2023^{\ast}$ 






















Tourists arrivals, 2020–2022.




