

### Population by five-year age groups and sex, 2019 (%)







### Population by age, 2019





### Live births by sex, 2017-2019





### Deaths by sex, 2017-2019









#### Immigrants and emigrants, 2017-2019





#### Marriages and divorces, 2017-2019










### Average annual net salaries and wages\*, 2017-2019 (RSD)


#### Registered unemployed by sex, 2017-2019\*





### Share of costs by activities in total expenditures of budgetary funds beneficiaries, 2018












### Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2011 (%)





### Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2011 (%)







### Coverage of children by the preparatory preschool programme, 2017–2019 (%)





### Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2019







#### Students enrolled in primary school, 2019 (%)













#### Children using accommodation services by type of accommodation, 2017-2019\*







#### Number of cash social assistance (income support) beneficiaries, 2017-2019\*





#### Number of child allowance beneficiaries, 2017-2019\*










### Convicted adults by place of commiting criminal offence and age group, 2019





#### Length of roads, 2019 (km)




