


Population by five-year age groups and sex, 2022 (%)



Live births by sex, 2020-2022



Deaths by sex, 2020-2022







Households according to the number of members, 2022 (%)






Marriages and divorces, 2020-2022




Average annual net salaries and wages*, 2021-2023 (RSD)





Registered employees by municipalities of residence Registered employees by municipalities of residence, 2020-2022*






Registered unemployed by sex, 2021-2023*




Registered unemployed per 1,000 inhabitants, by sex 2020–2022*
















Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2022 (%)











Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2018–2020 (%)







Students enrolled in primary school, 2022 (%)









Rate of underage births, 2020–2022 (per 1,000 maternals)












Number of cash social assistance (income support) beneficiaries (persons), 2021–2023*


Number of beneficiaries of basic allowance for assistance and care of another person by age group, 2023^{\ast}




















