




Live births by sex, 2017-2019

Population by age, 2019






Deaths by sex, 2017-2019

Neonatal mortality rate, 2017–2019 (Deaths per 1000 live births)





Households according to the number of members, 2011 (%)





Families with children by number of children, 2011






Average annual net salaries and wages*, 2017-2019 (RSD)











Members and labour regularly employed at family holding by sex, 2012 (%)






Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2011 (%)



Illiterate persons aged 10 and over by age groups and sex, 2011





Share of illiterate population in total population aged 10 and over by sex and type of settlement, 2011 (%)







Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2011 (%)








Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2019



Students enrolled in primary school, 2019 (%)








Incidence of tuberculosis, 2017–2019 (Per 100,000 population)







Number of beneficiaries of basic allowance for assistance and care of another person by age group, 2019*





Number of children (aged 6-17) in conflict with the law, 2017-2019







Convicted adults by place of commiting criminal offence and age group, 2019






Land area covered by forest, 2017 (ha)
