










Population by five-year age groups and sex, 2022 (%)



Population by age, 2022




Deaths by sex, 2020-2022














Average annual net salaries and wages*, 2021-2023 (RSD)





Registered employees by municipalities of residence, 2020-2022*






Registered unemployed by sex, 2021-2023*




Registered unemployed per 1,000 inhabitants, by sex 2020-2022*





Share of costs by activities in total expenditures of budgetary funds beneficiaries, 2022







Members and labour regularly employed at family holding by sex, 2012 (%)





Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2022 (%)






Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2022 (%)







Coverage of children by the preparatory preschool programme, 2020–2022 (%)



Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2018–2020 (%)







Students enrolled in primary school, 2022 (%)











Rate of underage births, 2020–2022 (per 1,000 maternals)













Number of beneficiaries of basic allowance for assistance and care of another person by age group, 2023^{\ast}



















Tourists arrivals, 2020–2022.




