

Population by five-year age groups and sex, 2022 (%)






#### Deaths by sex, 2020-2022


Population by age, 2022





Marriages and divorces, 2020–2022








#### Average annual net salaries and wages\*, 2021-2023 (RSD)





#### Registered employees by municipalities of residence, 2020-2022\*






#### Registered unemployed by sex, 2021-2023\*




### Registered unemployed per 1,000 inhabitants, by sex 2020–2022\*






Share of costs by activities in total expenditures of budgetary funds beneficiaries, 2022











Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2022 (%)







Coverage of children by the preparatory preschool programme, 2020–2022 (%)



Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2018–2020 (%)







#### Students enrolled in primary school, 2022 (%)






















