

Population by five-year age groups and sex, 2022 (%)







Population by age, 2022






Deaths by sex, 2020-2022



(Per 100,000 population)







Immigrants and emigrants, 2020-2022






Households according to the number of members, 2022 (%)

Neonatal mortality rate, 2020—2022 (Deaths of infants aged 0-27 days per 1,000 live births)












Average annual net salaries and wages*, 2021-2023 (RSD)



Registered employees by municipalities of residence, 2020–2022*





Registered employees by municipalities of residence comparing to population number, 2020-2022 (%)






Registered unemployed per 1,000 inhabitants, by sex 2020-2022*
















Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2022 (%)





Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2022 (%)















Students enrolled in primary school, 2022 (%)










Incidence of tuberculosis, 2020—2022 (Per 100,000 population)

Rate of underage births, 2020—2022 (per 1,000 maternals)





Total number of social protection beneficiaries registered at the Centre for Social Work, 2022





Children using accommodation services by type of accommodation, 2021–2023*







Number of cash social assistance (income support) beneficiaries (persons), 2021–2023*





Number of child allowance beneficiaries, 2021-2023*













Telephone subscribers, 2020-2022









Tourists arrivals, 2020-2022.




