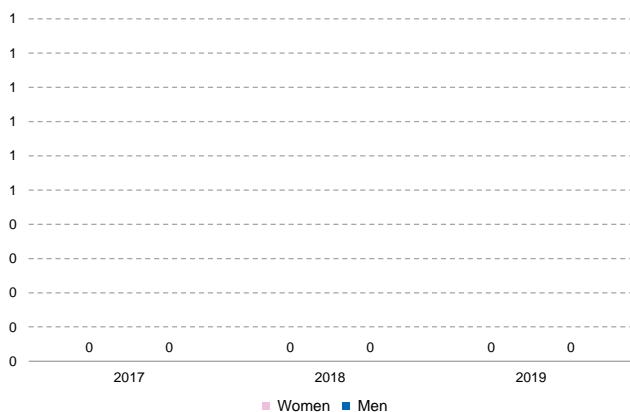

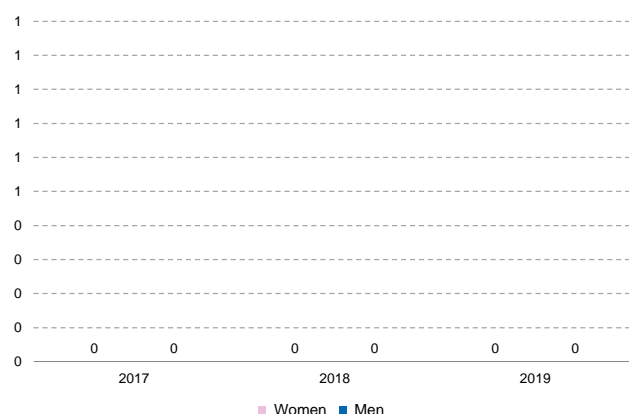

Live births by sex, 2017–2019



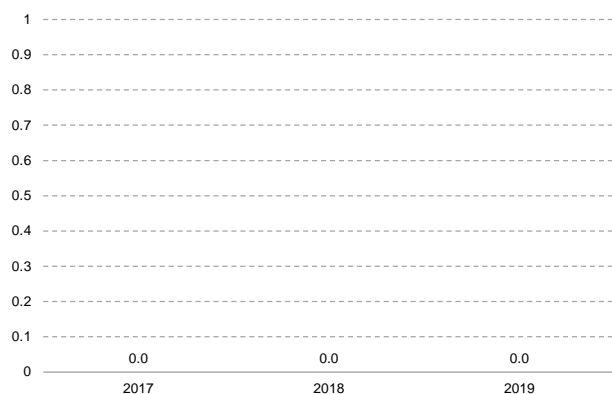

Deaths by sex, 2017–2019



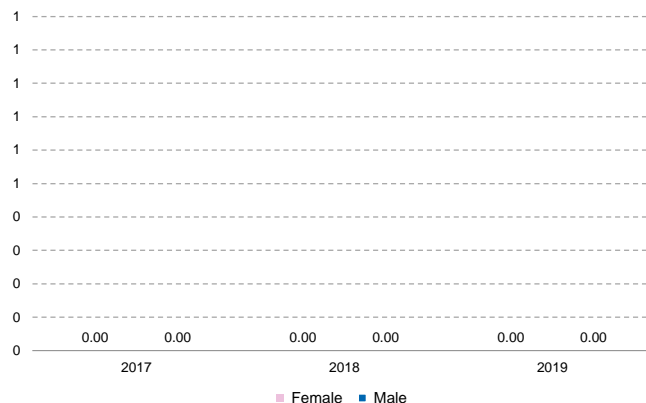

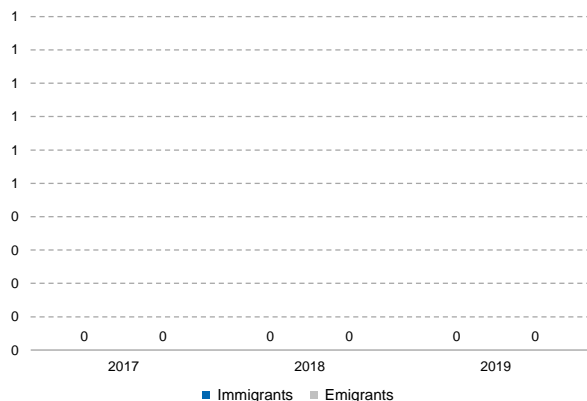

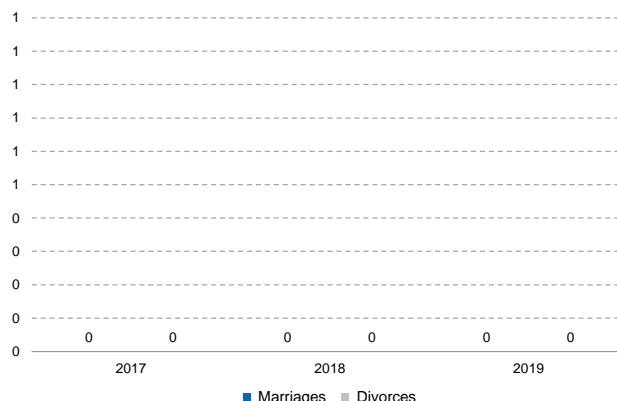

Immigrants and emigrants, 2017–2019



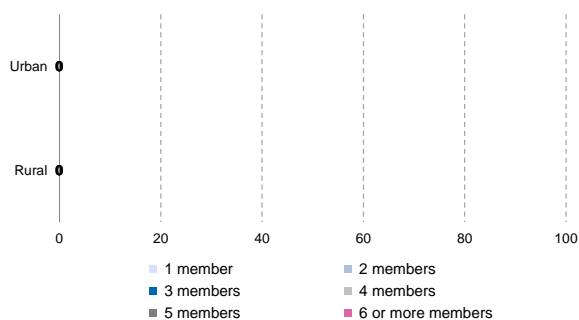

Marriages and divorces, 2017–2019



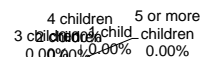

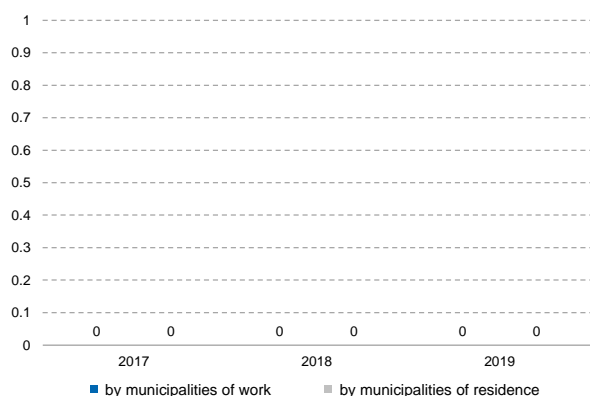
Average annual net salaries and wages*, 2018–2020 (RSD)

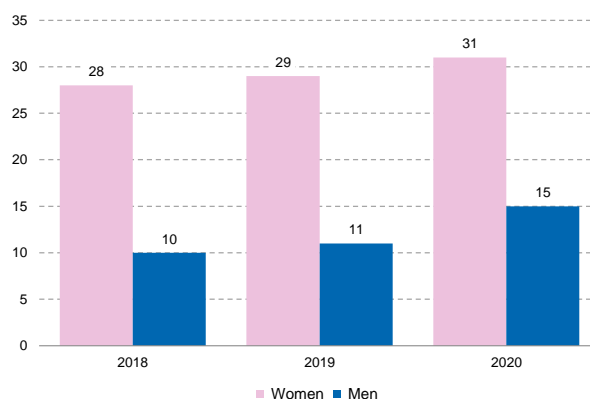

Registered employees, 2017–2019*



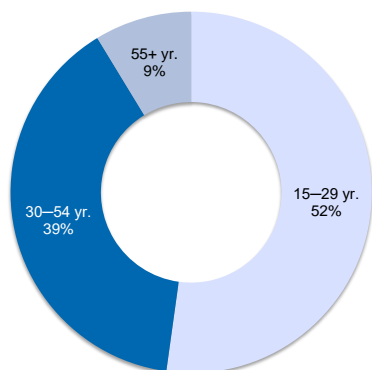

Registered unemployed by sex, 2018–2020*



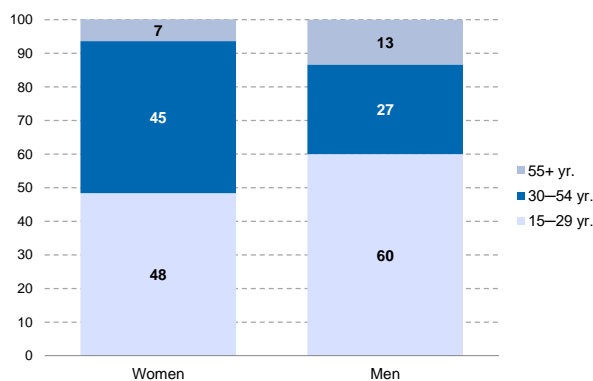

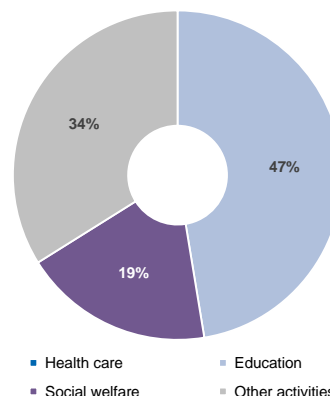

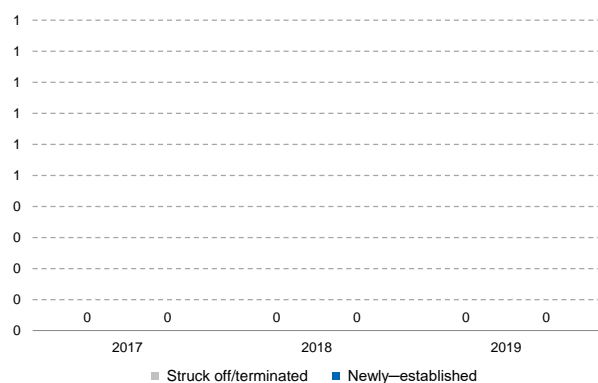

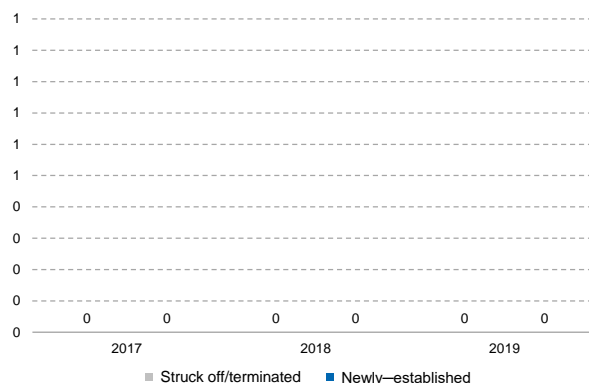

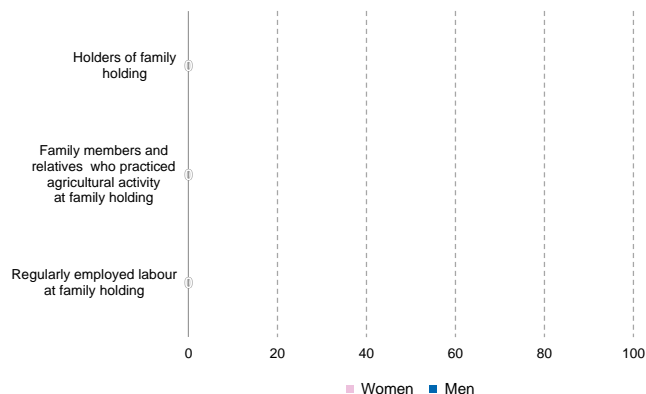

Members and labour regularly employed at family holding by sex, 2012 (%)



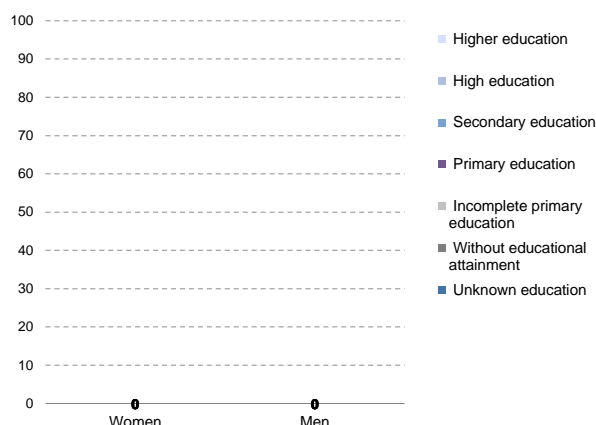

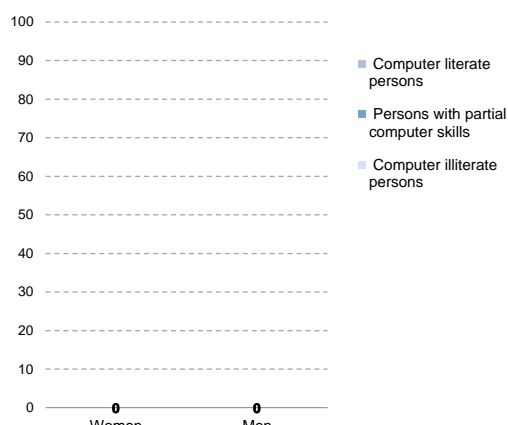

Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2011 (%)



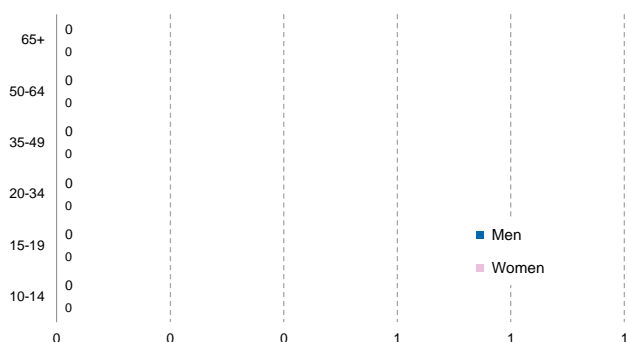

Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2011 (%)



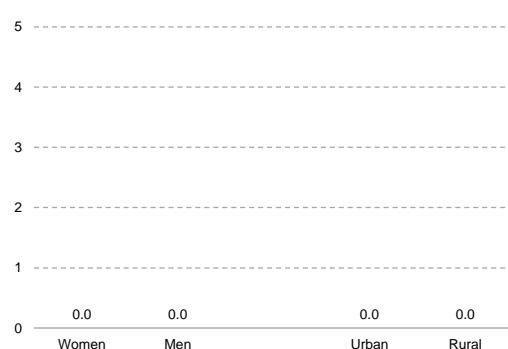

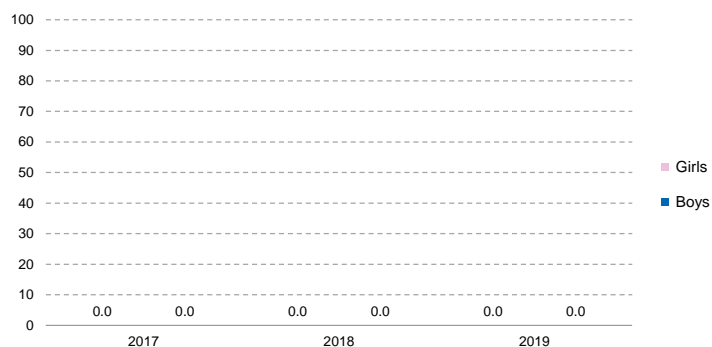

Coverage of children by the preparatory preschool programme, 2017–2019 (%)



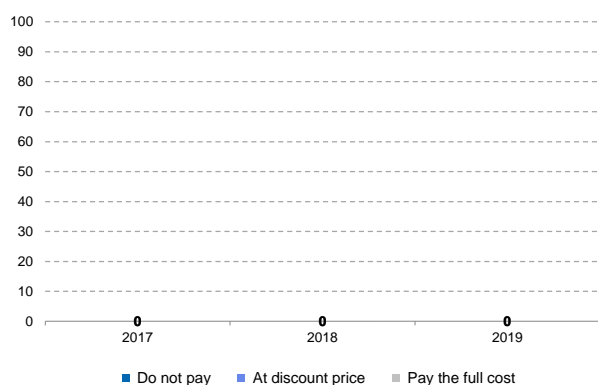

Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2017–2019 (%)



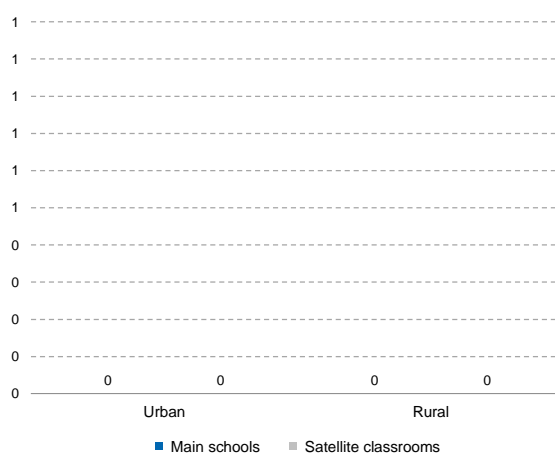

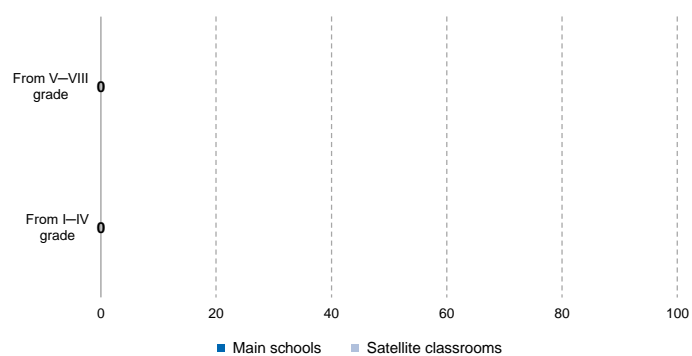

Students enrolled in primary school, 2020 (%)



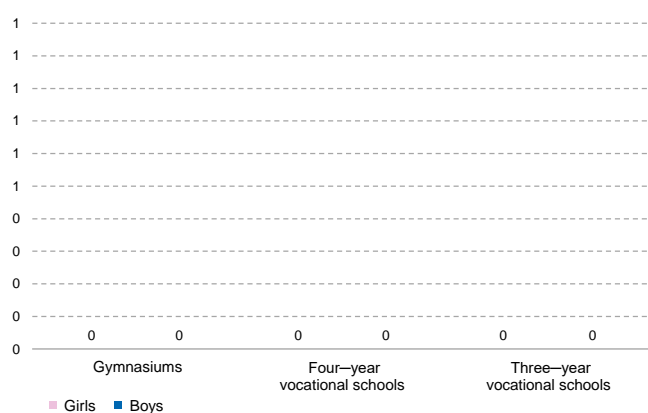

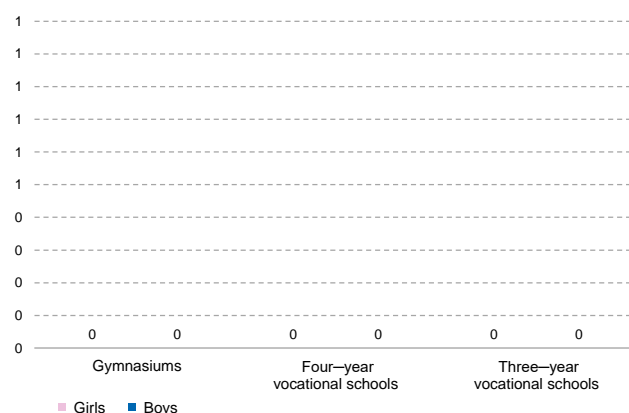

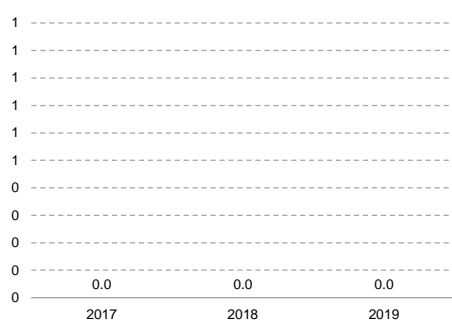

(Per 100,000 population)

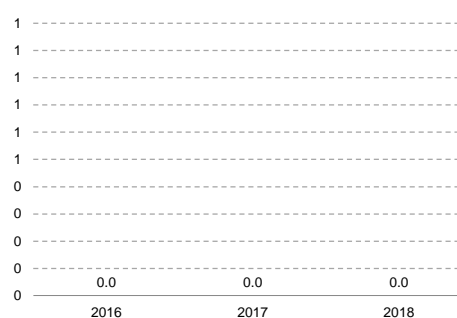

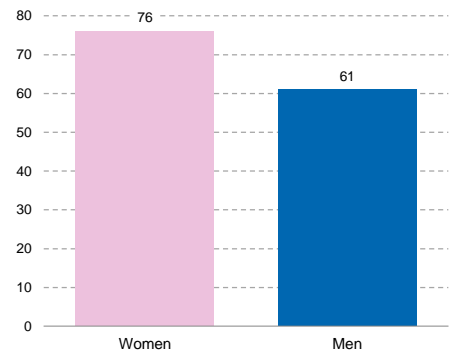

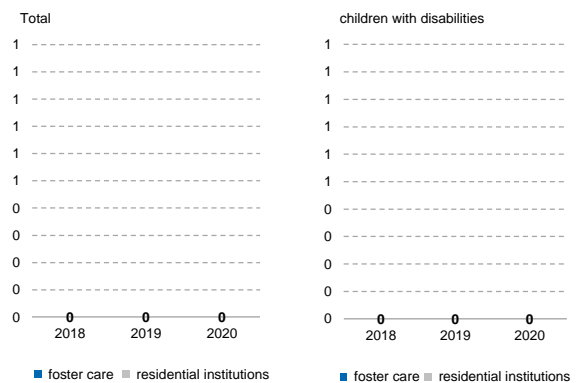

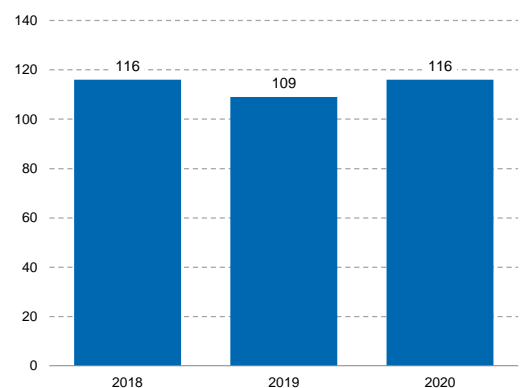

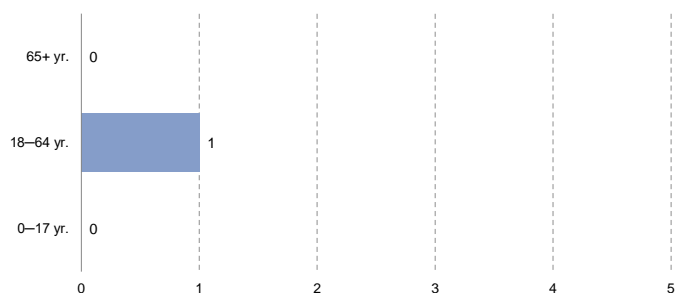
Number of cash social assistance (income support) beneficiaries, 2018–2020*

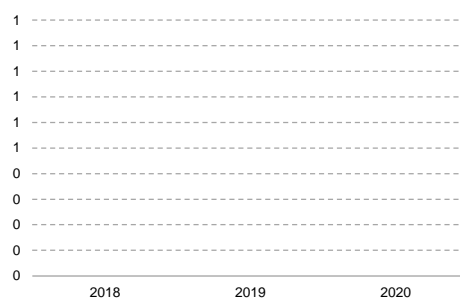
Number of beneficiaries of basic allowance for assistance and care of another person by age group, 2020*

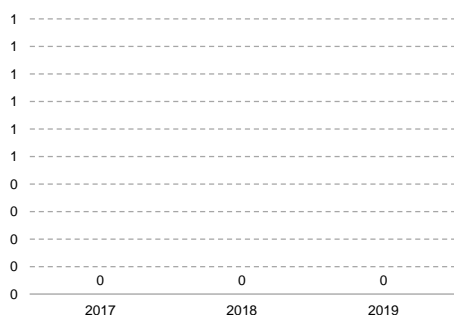

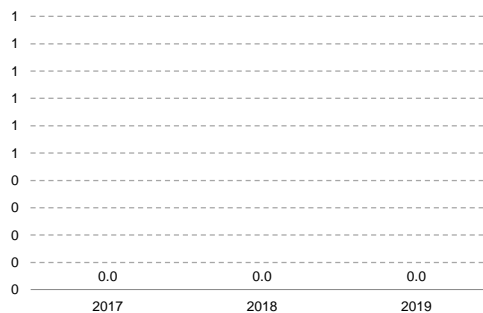

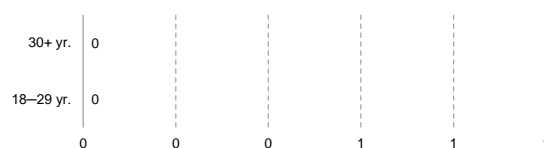

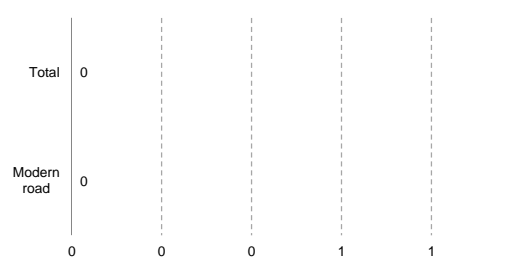

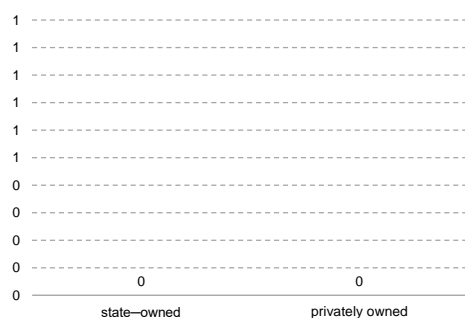

Length of roads, 2019 (km)



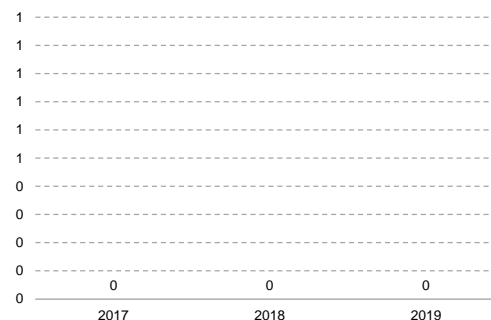
