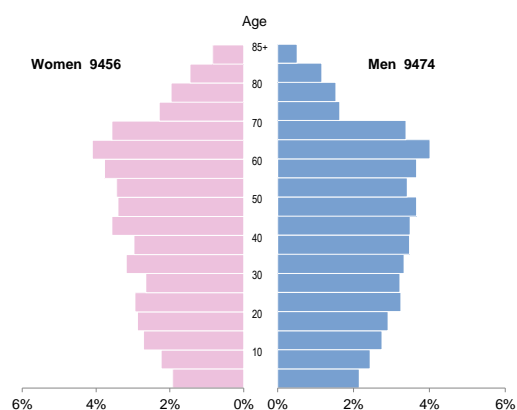

### Population by five-year age groups and sex, 2017



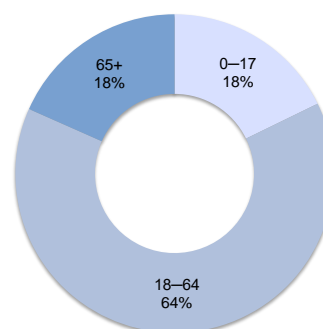

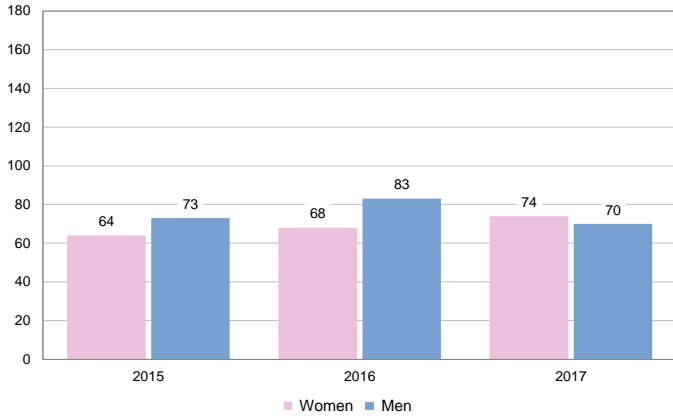

### Population by age, 2017



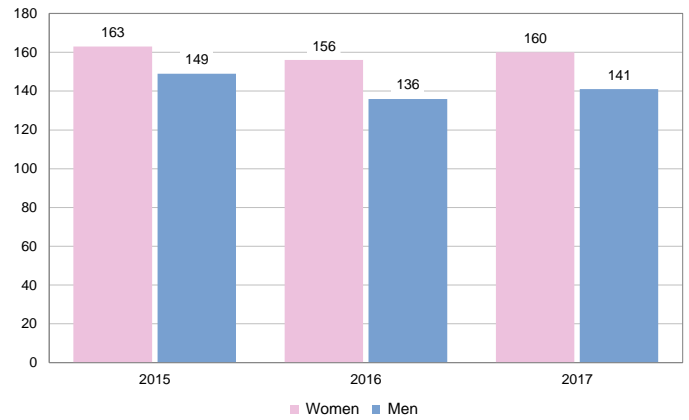

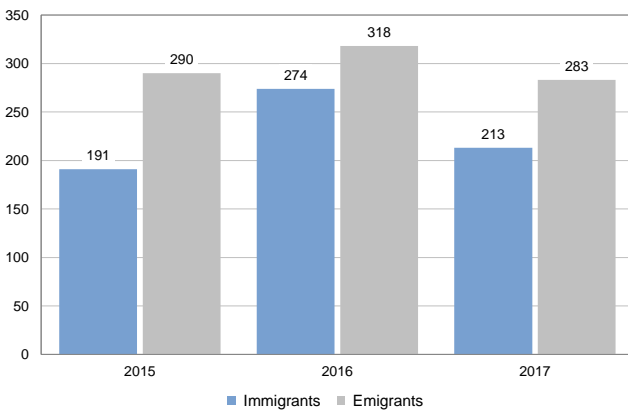

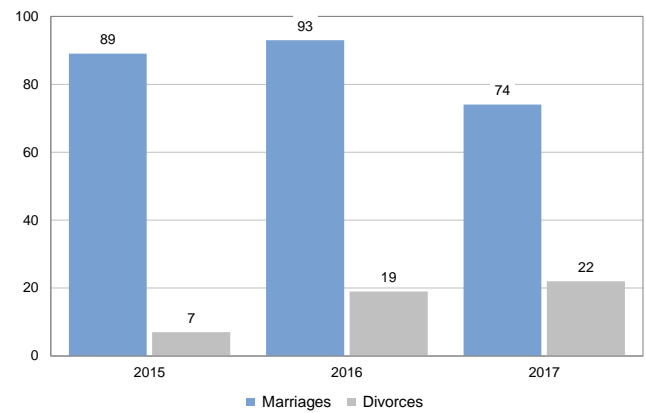

### Immigrants and emigrants, 2015–2017



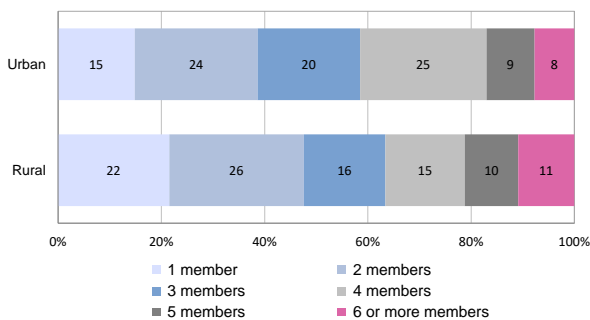

### Marriages and divorces, 2015–2017



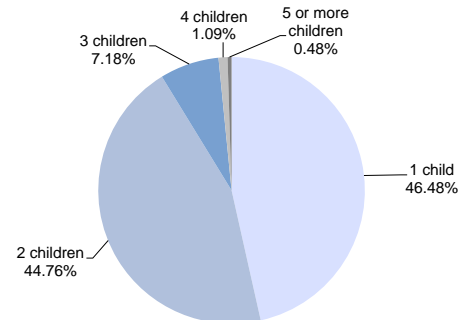

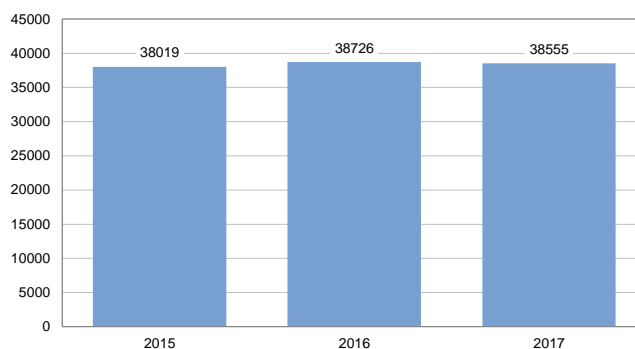

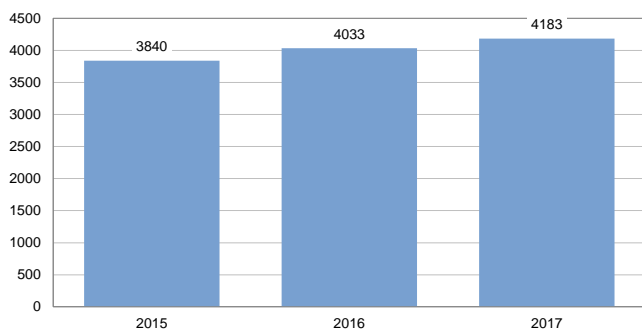

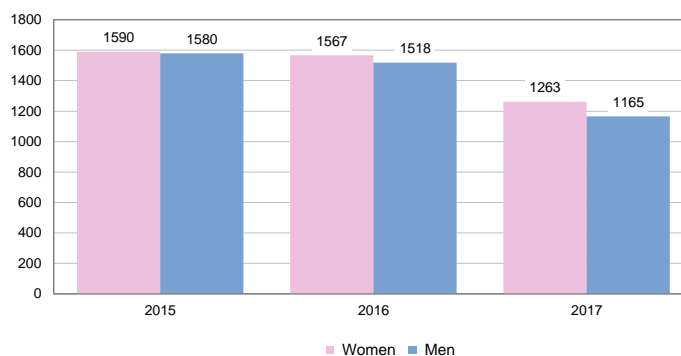
## Registered employees, 2015–2017\*

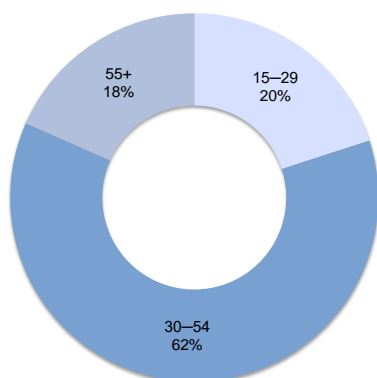

## Registered unemployed by sex, 2015–2017



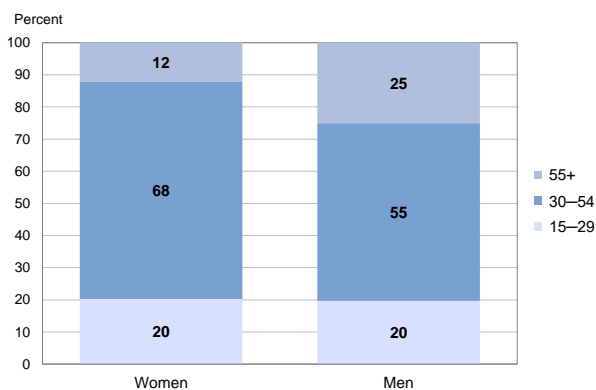

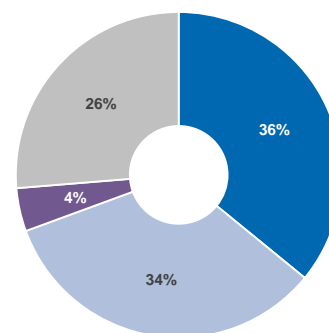

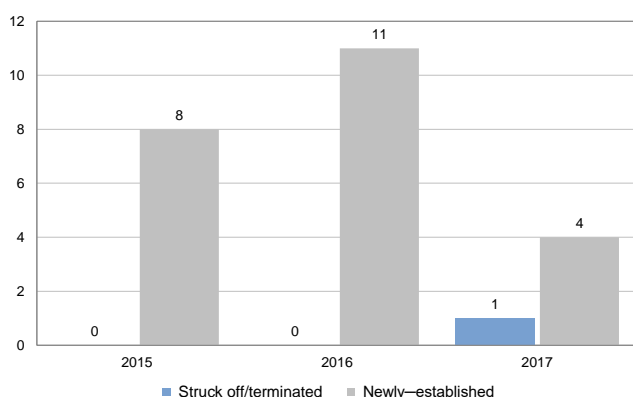

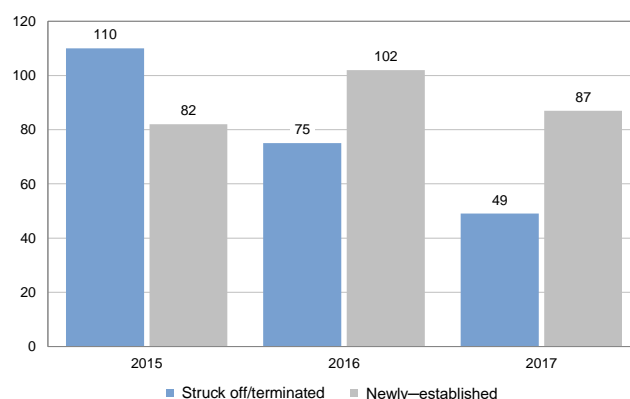

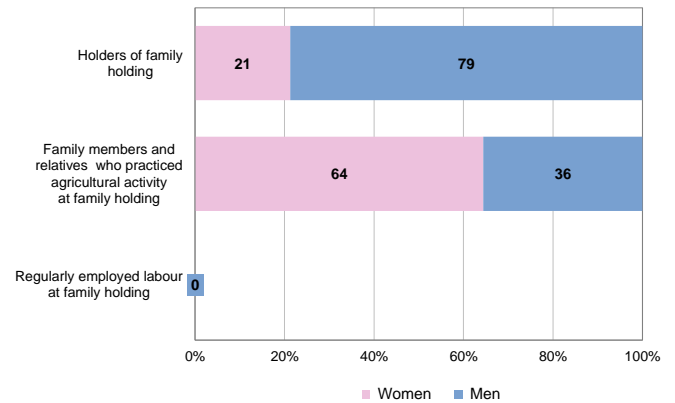

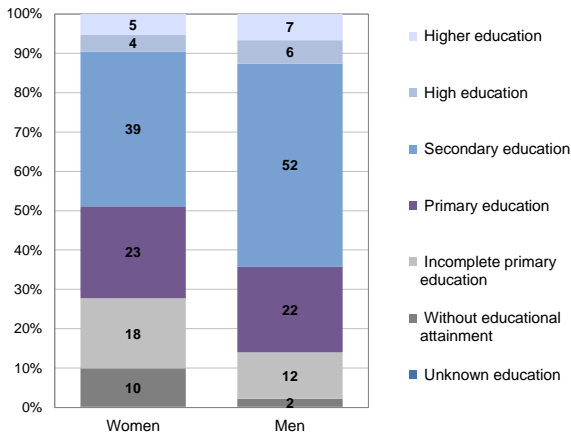

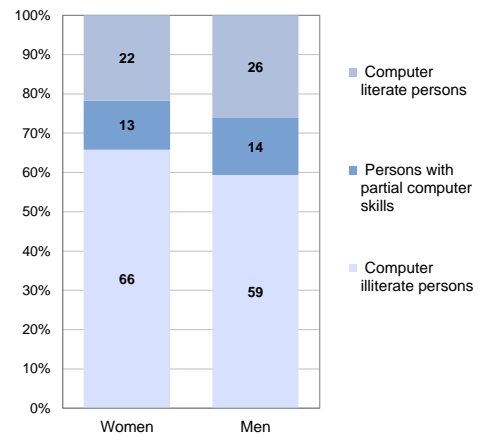

**Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2011**



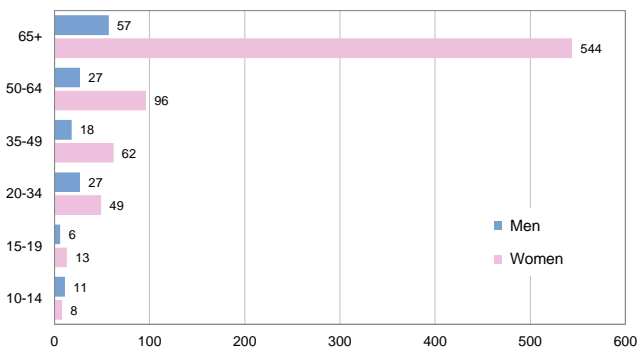

**Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2011**



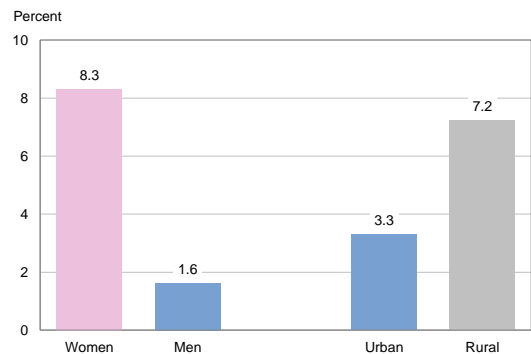

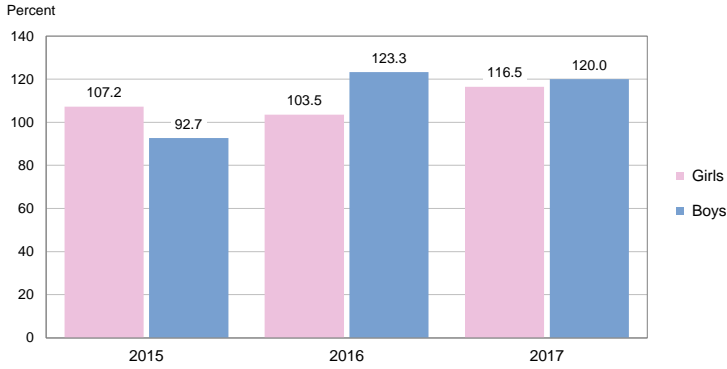

**Coverage of children by the preparatory preschool programme, 2015–2017**



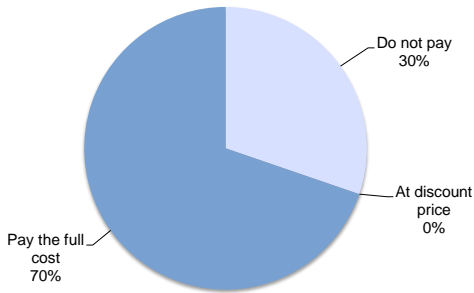

**Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2017**



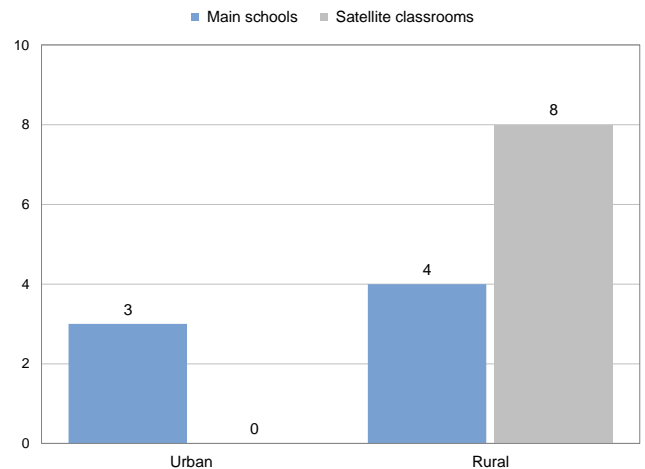

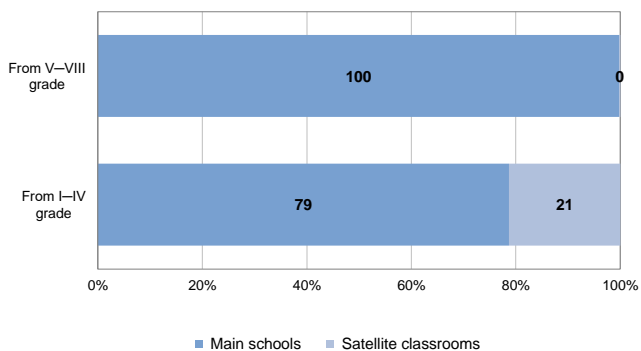

### Students enrolled in primary school, 2017 (%)



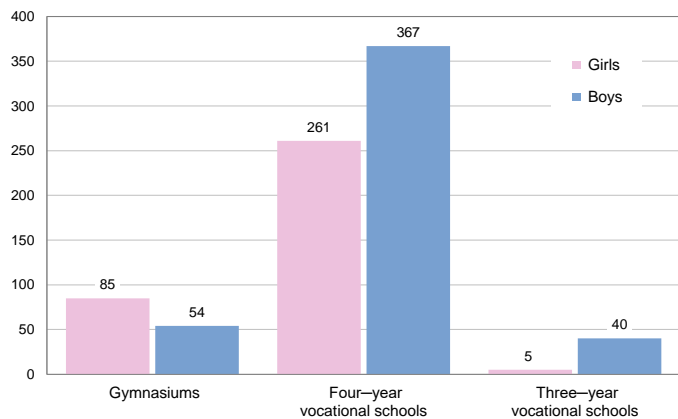

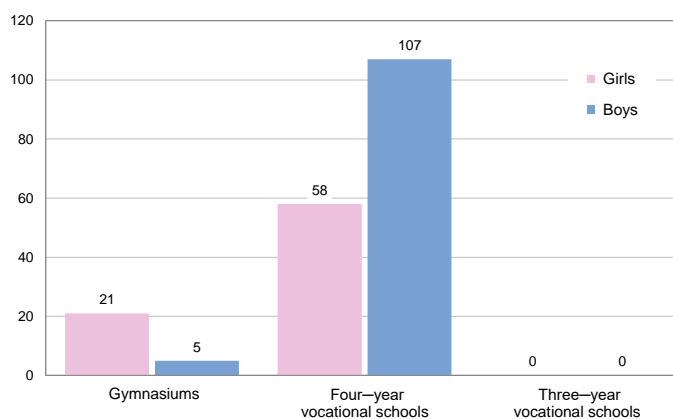

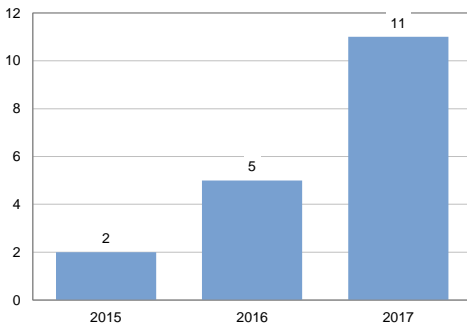

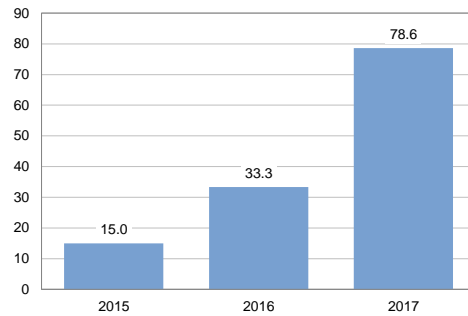

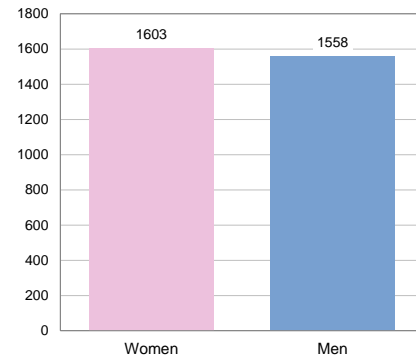

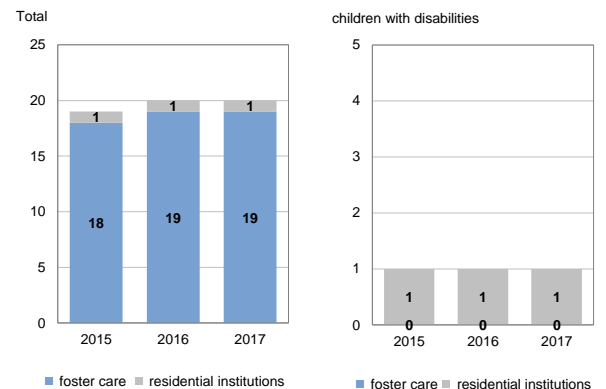

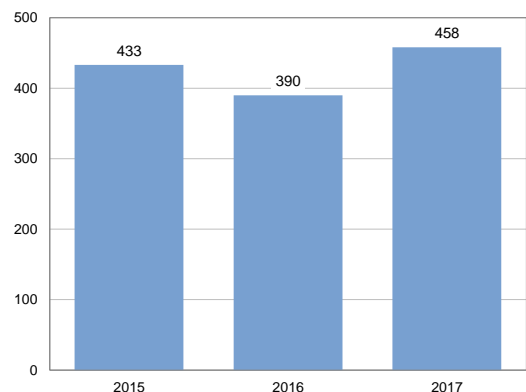

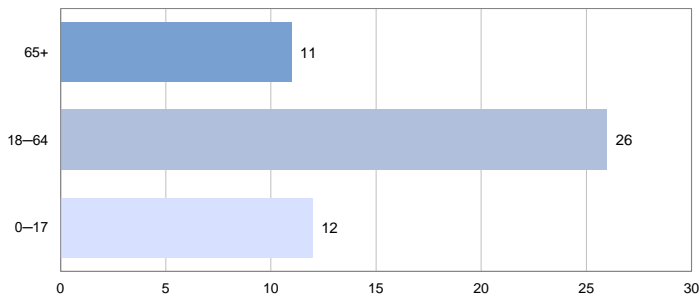
**Number of cash social assistance (income support) beneficiaries, 2015–2017\***

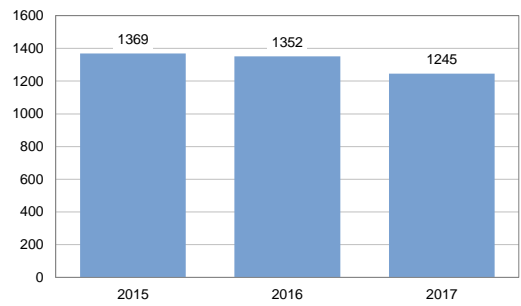

**Number of child allowance beneficiaries, 2015-2017\***



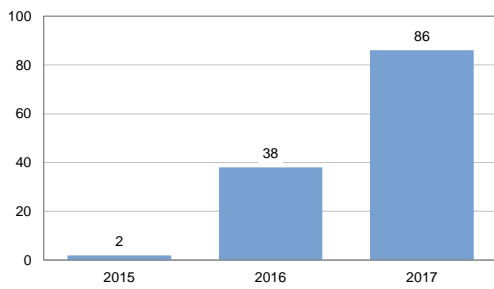

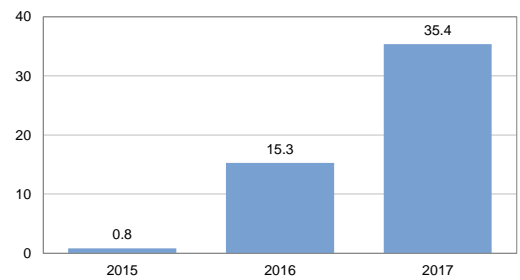

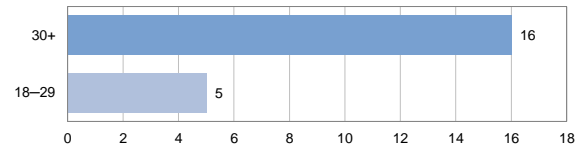

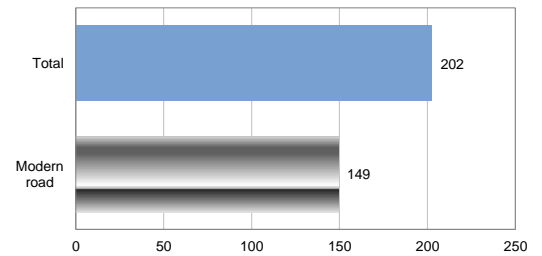

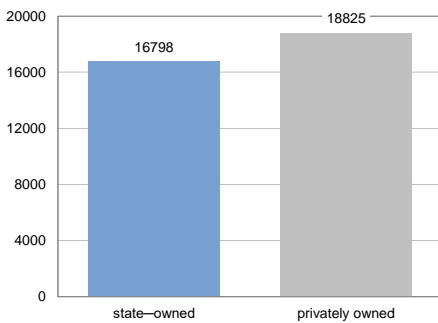

### Length of roads, 2017 (km)



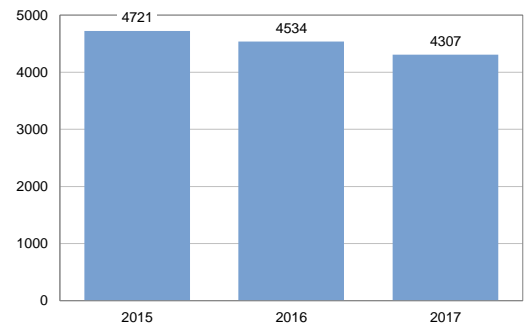
