





Population by age, 2022





### Live births by sex, 2020-2022





Deaths by sex, 2020-2022









Households according to the number of members, 2022 (%)








#### Average annual net salaries and wages\*, 2021-2023 (RSD)



#### Registered employees by municipalities of residence comparing to population number, 2020-2022 (%)




# Registered unemployed per 1,000 inhabitants, by sex 2020–2022\*




Share of costs by activities in total expenditures of budgetary funds beneficiaries, 2022







# Members and labour regularly employed at family holding by sex, 2012 (%)





# Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2022 (%)








Population aged 15 and over by computer literacy, 2022 (%)







Coverage of children by the preparatory preschool programme, 2020–2022 (%)



Children attending preschool education by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2018–2020 (%)







# Students enrolled in primary school, 2022 (%)











# Rate of underage births, 2020–2022 (per 1,000 maternals)







Children using accommodation services by type of accommodation, 2021–2023\*






#### Number of cash social assistance (income support) beneficiaries (persons), 2021–2023\*





#### Number of child allowance beneficiaries, 2021-2023\*



















Tourists arrivals, 2020–2022.




